Accused Molester Convicted

A former boy scout leader accused of molesting a 13-year-old girl was found guilty by a jury Friday evening.

Albert W. Otte, 33, of Seven Hill Road, Chicora R.D. 3, was found guilty of involuntary deviate sexual intercourse, corruption of minors and indecent exposure.

The eight-woman, four-man jury, which deliberated for more than six hours, found him not guilty of statutory rape.

Otte remains free on bond pending an appeal of the verdict within 10 days.

Otte was accused of touching and later forcing sex on a Butler girl who was 13 at the time of the incidents. The assaults occurred in 1989 and 1990 in Butler where he lived at that time.

During testimony Thursday, the girl said Otte began the encounters by explaining what he thought she ought to know about men and women's sexual organs and how to check for breast cancer. As time went on, he touched her body parts while he explained them and later the touching progressed into sex, the girl testified.

The teen-ager said she did not report the incident to anyone because she was afraid of Otte since he had hit and kicked her previously.

The Oakland Township man suffers from seizures and had an often violent personality that is currently controlled by medication, according to his own testimony.

Otte had a job driving a van for United Cerebral Palsy in Butler County until his seizures became too dangerous, he said. He no longer works, and receives social security disability compensation.

Assistant District Attorney William Shaffer brought up part of Otte's criminal record during court Thursday.

REVIEW PROCEDURES

- 5. You will receive a letter setting forth the decision of the committee.
- 6. If you disagree with the decision of the committee, you may request a review of this decision by the National Council of the Boy Scouts of America.
