PIERSON is wanted on a warrant of apprehension for obtaining property by deception committed on McNaughtons Hardware at Richmond on the 21st October, 1987. He is also wanted for interview in relation to a large number of other small deceptions. The warrant of apprehension is filed at I.B.R. A photo is produced and is of good likeness.

2. PIERSON is a former police officer in America. He is a pedophile and it is believed that he has an infatuation with scouts and scout groups. It is believed his will attend these sorts of places.




