

# Grand jury indicts three for sexual abuse crimes involving local children

SMITHVILLE — A former Boy Scout leader has been indicted for indecency with a child.

Billy McMillan of Smithville was arrested Monday evening and was placed in the Bastrop County jail under a \$10,000 bond. The Bastrop County Grand Jury handed down the indictment last Wednesday (May 28).

McMillan was one of three men indicted last week for sexual abuse of children. The grand jury also indicted Roger Hayes of Cedar Creek for indecency with a child and Ralph Howes, in an Elgin case, for sexual assault of a child. Hayes is under a \$10,000 bond and Howes is held under a \$5,000 bond.

McMillan was indicted based on the video-taped testimony of a Smithville boy, according to Smithville police chief Larry Barmore. The boy told authorities that that McMillan approached him early in the afternoon of Saturday, May 24. According to a police report. McMillan, whom the juvenile recognized as a Boy Scout leader, asked the boy if he wanted to go to McMillan's house and watch "Loonev Tunes."

The boy agreed. Once at the house, McMillan showed the boy obscene magazines; McMillan then sat down next to the boy "and started kissing and hugging him," according to the police report. The boy moved away and said he had to leave within 30 minutes. The police report says McMillan then offered the boy \$5 and then \$10 to disrobe.

The boy refused, the police report

stated, and then left the house. The boy went home, told his mother the series of events and they, with the help of a neighbor, called the Smithville police. The Smithville police contacted the Bastrop County district attorney's office, according to Barmore, and investigator Georgia Compton video taped the boy's testimony.

The tape was shown to the grand jury the following Wednesday and the inductment was handed down that day.

Barmore said that McMillan has a "clean record" and that the indictment stems from only this single incident. Barmore said the incident was not related to any Boy Scout activities.

The grand jury indicted seven other individuals last Wednesday:

- -Anthony F. Wilson was indicted for unauthorized use of a motor vehicle.
- —Johnny Benito Areilano (a.k.a. Johnny Hernandez) was indicted for an April 18 burglary of a house owned by Chris Tijerina.
- —David W. Henke was indicted for the theft of grain owned by Edwin O. Lundgren, Jr. and valued at over \$20,000.
- —Sharon Denise Moschella was indicted for possession of between 50 and 200 pounds of manijuana and was placed under a \$50,000 bond.
- —William Stull, Jr., was indicted for the possession of a controlled substance and was placed under a \$21,000 bond.
- —Eric Wilkins was indicted for arson. He is accused of attempting to burn down a house owned by Laura Wilkins.
