## Grounds for prosecution

• Corning City Judge James B. Githler ruled Tuesday that there are sufficient grounds to pursue prosecution of a 23-year-old Corning man charged with involvement in the theft of \$2,500 in Steuben Glassware from the Corning Glass Center.

Michael A. Barney of 143 Decatur St. is charged with second-degree possession of stolen property.

Assistant District Attorney James A. Esgrow said Githler made the ruling in a preliminary hearing.

Esgrow said bail was set, but he did not know if it was posted.

Barney is named as a co-defendant with Anthony D. Spaulding, 22, of 73 W. William St., in the theft of the glassware from the Corning Glass Center. The men were arrested Feb. 8. Spaulding will appear in city court today.

Robert Wake, operations manager of the Corning Glass Center, testified at the hearing

"The felony complaint alleges that the glassware was in excess of \$500 dollars. The complaint involves a (glass) dolphin and a mushroom," Esgrow said. The complaint refers to the glass Barney allegedly had in his possession at the time of his arrest.

Esgrow said others were named in the chain of possession of the stolen glass.

Police found the pieces in a home, a trash can behind a Convienent store, and in Denison Park.

• Myron Speicher, 26, of 94 E. Third St., Corning, was arraigned Tuesday in City Court on a charge of fourth-degree criminal possession of a weapon. The case was adjourned to Feb. 16.

Speicher was arrested Feb. 7 for allegedly threatening a Corning City police officer with a rifle. The incident took place in an apartment above a Market Street store.

In other city court action Tuesday: Gary Davis, 42, of 2 College Ave., Corning, was arraigned on a charge of trespassing. The case was adjourned to March 1. He was

arrested Feb. 9.

Luceritte Crane, 31, of 163 Wall St., Corning, was arraigned on a charge of driving while intoxicated (DWI) and refusing to take a chemical test. The case: was adjourned to Feb. 23. Crane was arrested Feb. 9.

Bradford Kaopuiki, 36, of the Stanton Hotel, Corning, has his case transferred to Steubne County Court after his appearance in city court. He is charged with first-degree sexual abuse.

 Corning City Police are investigating two burglaries which occurred over the weekend.

The first occurred Saturday at the home of Leona Smith of 109 W. First St. Smith's wallet and change purse containing \$199 were stolen.

In the second incident, the home of Carl

Mogren of 341 Dodge Ave. was was was burgularized. Police say the house was apparently broken into, and more than one person committed the theft.

Among the items stolen were a watch given to Mogren for 30 years service from Weyerhaeuser Co., a black onyx ring, and 12 cases of Pabst beer.
