# -Napa man convicted of molestation-

By LESLIE WEINFIELD Register Staff Writer

A Napa man was convicted by a Superior Court jury today of molesting a young boy who was a member of his Boy Scout troop and with whos! family he was close friends.

A five-woman, seven-man jury deliberated some two hours before convicting Charles Edward Lawrence, 32, of two counts of lewd and lascivious behavior and one count of oral copulation with a minor under 14.

ingo on each count that force was used, and that Lawrence occupied a position of special trust with the victim. Lawrence was acquitted of charges of kidnapping the boy for molestation purposes.

Through his attorney, Lawrence indicated the verdict will be ap-

pealed.
Although Lawrence has been free on \$30,000 bail, he was remanded to custody in Napa County jall today to await a hearing Wednesday in which the County Probation Department will make recommends.

tions on whether he can continue to stay out of fail. A sentencing date may also be set at that time.

Patrick Clancy, Lawrence's lawyer, also said he would ask at the sentencing for ball on appeal of the case, which would mean Lawrence would remain free until the appeal had been decided.

During the four-day trial, the prosecution based much of its case on a tape recording of a call the victim placed to Lawrence that was taped by authorities on the case.

In it, the young boy asks Lawrence about the molestation incl-dents and mentious he is considering telling his parents.

The boy also tells Lawrence he has already told another young friend, to which Lawrence replied, "I guess the cat's out of the bag."

In defense testimony Wednesday,
Lawrence said he used that phrase

false story to his friends, and that
he was worried such a tale could

Lawrence said he took the child hiking and fishing, and also built a skateboard ramp for him at one point.

"confused" by the boy's call and allegations, said he eventually told the youth, "You know I'd kill myself for doing what I've done" to placate the youth's insistence that incidents of molestation had occurred.

However, under cross examination by Mark Sheedy, deputy district attorney, Lawrence said he declined to tell the boy to get his parents and get the matter straightened out immediately.

"I had no reason to believe it to be true, so why get upset about it," Lawrence said Wednesday. "There was nothing I could do about it circulating. If something had come up, I would have discussed it;"

## Bail refused for convicted child molester

Napa Registr 5/30/90

A Superior Court judge today refused to allow bail for Charles Edward Lawrence of Napa, convicted last week of molesting a member of his Boy Scout troop whose family he had known for many years.

Citing community safety and a Probation Department recommendation against bail, Judge Philip Champlin ordered Lawrence, 32, held in Napa County Jail without bail until sentencing June 29.

Lawrence indicated upon his conviction by a jury Friday he intended to appeal, and his lawyer sought to have him released on bail pending the outcome of that motion.

Citing a defense-procured psychiatric evaluation that indicated his client could be classified as a situational, one-time offender rather than a psychopathic one, defense lawyer Patrick Clancy said Lawrence could be trusted to abide by bail conditions that would keep him away from the boy and his family.

Mark Sheedy, deputy district attorney, said the independent court-ordered psychiatric evaluation indicated the defendant has the capacity to commit another offense and is not a candidate for therapy.

"I'm not saying he will (reoffend), but...it cannot be ruled out," Sheedy said.

Champlin called the situation "terribly sad," but noted Lawrence had been convicted of "very serious charges" including the use of force.

"These kinds of things go to the very heart of parental fears. The safety of the community weighs heavily in favor of following the Probation Department recommendation against bail," Champlin

said.

### BAIL EXPIRES

An 82-year-old Calistoga man accused of killing his wife last May, allegedly because she was in failing health, was released on his own recognizance in Superior Court today.

Robert Edwards is accused of murdering his wife, Muriel M. Edwards, who was found in the couple's mobile home with a plastic sheet over her head.

Police and court records indicate . she had suffered a stroke recently before her death.

Mr. Edwards had been free on a \$20,000 bail bond set to expire next month, so his attorney requested the OR release from Judge Philip Champlin based on the defendant's community standing and lack of prior offenses.

The case will be tried in Superior Court Sept. 10.

### MOLESTATION SENTENCE

Sentencing for an elderly St. Helena man convicted of annoying or molesting an underage child in August 1987, was put off pending an extensive psychiatric evaluation.

Robert Gaut, 77, will be incarcerated at the California Medical Facility in Vacaville for the evaluation, expected to last several months, said Mark Sheedy, deputy district attorney.

He will return to court at a later date with recommendations on whether probation or a prison sentence would be appropriate.

He will receive credit for the time spent at the prison medical facility.

### APPLICANT PROCEDURE FOR REQUESTING REVIEW OF DECISION DENYING REGISTRATION

- 1. If registration is refused, the applicant may request a review of this decision. The request must be in the form of a written request from the individual which includes his or her version of the facts supporting the claim that registration should not have been denied.
- 2. Upon receipt of the written request for review, the president of the local council shall appoint a committee to review the situation.
- 3. The appointed committee should review the facts as presented, and, in addition, may interview any persons whose testimony might assist the committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a correct decision.
- 4. A confidential report will be given to the applicant setting forth the decision of the committee.
- 5. The applicant may-if he or she does not agree with the decision -request a review from the regional director by submitting a written request for such a review within 30 days of the receipt of the local council decision.
- 6. If the regional review does not satisfy the applicant, he or she may ask for further review by the National Council by submitting a written request for such a review within 30 days of the receipt of the regional decision. The decision of the National council is final.
