
Dear Mr. Newman:

The Review Committee convened at 2:00 PM, March 29, at MBank in Longview as we had agreed. At 2:45 PM the Committee decided to proceed with the meeting without you. The Committee reviewed the action previously taken by the council as regards your membership in the Boy Scouts of America.

The Committee upheld the previous action, refusing your membership in the Boy Scouts. The reported conduct is not consistent with Boy Scout principles.

The decision of the Review Committee is subject to review by a Regional-level Committee. To initiate this process you must write, within 30 days, to Regional President Glenn Cox, South Central Region, BSA, P. O. Box 152325, Irving, Texas 75015-2325, explaining why you believe the decision is in error.

MINUTES OF MARCH 29, 1989 REVIEW COMMITTEE MEETING CONCERNING DENIAL OF
CHARLES R. NEWMAN REGISTRATION

Those present were: Chairman Lemuel C. Hutchins, R. E. Peppy Blount, and David Wade.
Scout Executive Richard H. Austin was also present.

Charles R. Newman had been invited by telephone through conversations with his wife to
attend the meeting at 2:00 PM at MBank in Longview. At 2:15 PM, Austin called [REDACTED]
who expressed surprise that Mr. Newman was not there as he had left at 1:45 PM for
the meeting.

Chairman Hutchins, noting that Newman did not actually have to be present for the review
to be held, convened the meeting at 2:48 PM, without him.

After reviewing the material pertinent to the leadership question, i.e.: improper
advances to a minor girl and professions to her of being in love with her, Chairman
Lemuel C. Hutchins made the following motion:

Without further investigation, the committee upheld the previous action of
the council regarding Mr. Newman's registration since his conduct was not
consistent with Boy Scout Leader principles. Peppy Blount gave the second,
the motion passed unanimously.

It was then pointed out by Hutchins that this action was not meant to exclude Mr. Newman
from attendance in scheduled parental Scouting activities, but would continue to deny
membership in the program.

Austin agreed to print the minutes, be sure Mr. Newman received a copy, and to notify
the National Office as prescribed in Appendix D of the "Procedures For Maintaining
Standards of Membership". (In reviewing Item 14 of Appendix D, I note that a summary
letter be sent rather than Minutes, so I have done that.)

The meeting was adjourned at 3:15 PM.






