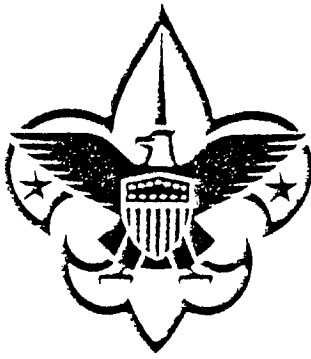





Dear Mr. Ragucci:

This letter is in response to your letter of July 19, 1988. It is my decision to appeal your decision to permanently suspend my registration as a member of the Boy Scouts of America.

You state the charges by two Scouts in Troop 37 have no bearing on your decision. Therefore, I will not address these allegations.

You then go on to state that there was an incident at a summer cabin in October, 1986, wherein Scouts were allowed to drink champagne and to view alleged X-rated video. Nothing occurred at my cabin in October, 1986. However, there was an incident almost a year previous, involving some Scouts finding an X-rated movie at the cabin and putting this X-rated movie in a VCR. When I realized that they had done this, I was the one who told them to actually remove the X-rated video.

Additionally, you state that in letters of August 26, 1987 and November 25, 1987, you requested that I sever any relations that I had with the Boy Scouts of America. In May, 1987, I was called in to see Father Quigley of St. Teresa's Church. Father Quigley informed me that he had become aware of certain allegations made by two Scouts in Troop 37. Father Quigley indicated to me that no charges would be brought against me if I did not participate in Scouting. After my conversation with Father Quigley, I sought legal advice and conferred with my lawyer, William M. Fredreck.

After my consultation with Mr. Fredreck, the decision was made that I should resign from the Boy Scouts because in his opinion "discretion was the better part of valor". Under the legal advice given to me by my attorney, I did not participate

in Boy Scout activities until after I was arrested in August, 1987.

My decision not to participate in Scouting which was made in May, 1987 was contingent upon the fact that no charges would be brought against me. Despite the fact that I did not participate in Scouting, charges were in fact, brought against me. From that date up to and including the present, I continually denied any of those charges and, as stated above, I will not address those charges because you state that those charges have no bearing in your decision.

When my attorney found out about these charges, he advised me to continue with my activities in Scouting. It was his concern, and mine, that if I remained out of Scouting that in the future these actions may be taken as a consciousness of guilt on my part. Because I am innocent of any and all charges that were brought against me in August, 1987, I followed my attorney's advice and continued in Scouting so that there could be no unfavorable inference drawn against me in the future. I should not be penalized for following legal advice.

As to the allegation that I camped with Troop 52 in March, 1988, this is not true. The facts are that a personal friend of mine was camping at that time and I went to check on his well being after a severe rain storm that morning. Upon my arrival at the campsite, police were investigating something on the grounds and they asked questions of people in the area including myself. But it must be stressed I did not camp with Troop 52.

The only reason I used envelopes was to return official Boy Scout records, which I had been requested to do. I did not want these records misplaced, therefore, in my judgment, the proper thing to do was to return them in a GNYC address envelope.

As to my attending Troop 21's Court of Honor in April, 1988, I did attend as a guest and not in uniform. I did not attend this Court of Honor in any official Boy Scout capacity, but only as an invited guest.

Therefore in summary, I categorically deny the original incident which you allege occurred in October, 1986 and state

that the only reason for not complying with the Council's request to "sever all relations" with Scouting was on my attorney's advice. Certain representations had been made to my in May, 1987 (as outlined above), and these representations were not lived up to. I respectfully submit that I should not be severed or discharged from Scouting because I followed legal advice. It is certainly my hope that any member of the Boy Scouts of America who has a legal problem would follow the advice of their attorney. Therefore, I respectfully submit that my "response" does meet the standards that are followed by the Boy Scouts of America.

It should be added that in a meeting held in Mr. Stallone's office on April 26, 1988, and attended by myself, my attorney and Mr. Hassler that an understanding was reached. This understanding was contingent upon certain representations made by the District Attorney's Office. However, after the meeting of April 26, 1988, the District Attorney's Office reneged on their representations and as a result I had to renege on my understanding. Reference is made to my attorney's letter to Martin V. Stallone, dated June 21, 1988 and enclosed herewith.

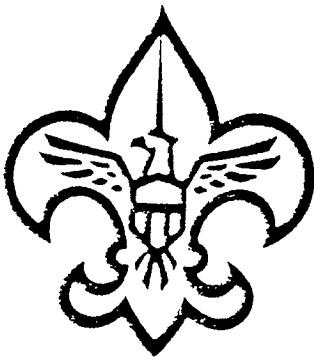
Therefore, I respectfully request that your decision be reviewed by a Council review committee.

Dear Chris:

This is in reply to your letter of June 21, 1988, stating you have difficulty in preparing a letter asking for a review of our decision to permanently suspend your registration.

Our letter is based on our decision that you do not now meet the high standards of leadership the Boy Scouts of America seeks to provide for American youth. The following reasons are submitted.

A. The original temporary suspension was for two major reasons. (This was in our letter of August 26th).

1) Charges by two Scouts in Troop 37. (This now is a separate action and has no bearing on our recent decision. Outcome of this action is pending.)

2) The incident at your summer cabin in October 1985, questioned your continued leadership in our program. Scouts were allowed to drink champagne and to view X-rated video (sexually explicit). This was not denied by you.

B. Our letter of August 26, 1987, suspended your registration and requested that "you immediately sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. This request was ignored.

C. On November 25, 1987, we again wrote to you stating that we had been informed that you had not severed all relations and again we requested to cease ALL relations immediately. Again, this request was ignored.


- D. We have, on record, written proof that you again did not comply. You camped, and were associated with Troop 52 at Snug Harbor in March, 1988, and again, at Treasure Island in April, 1988. You also indicated association with the BSA by using GNYC address envelopes, with your address label underneath (envelope dated March, 1988). In April, 1988, you attended Troop 21's Court of Honor.


All of the above reasons were given to you personally at the meeting in Martin V. Stallone's office on April 26, 1988, with your lawyer present.

The original incident (October, 1986) coupled with your complete lack of complying with, and the utter disregard of the Council's repeated requests to "sever all relations" caused the Council President Martin V. Stallone and Scout Executive Rheinhardt H. Hassler to permanently suspend your registration, and to refund your registration fees. This type of response does not meet the standards of leadership desired by the Boy Scouts of America. Leader registration is a privilege and can be withdrawn.

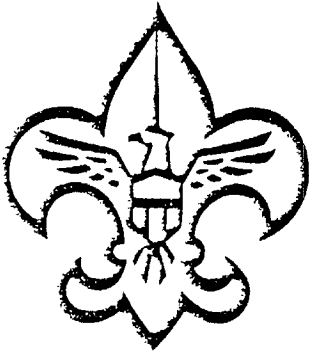

* Case is still pending in DA's office. Looks like it will finally go to trail in June, 1988.

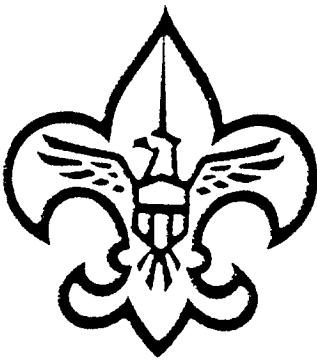

APPLICANT PROCEDURE FOR REQUESTING REVIEW OF DECISION DENYING REGISTRATION

1. If registration is refused, the applicant may request a review of this decision. This request must be in the form of a written request from the individual which includes his or her version of the facts supporting the claim that registration should not have been denied.
2. Upon receipt of the written request for review, the president of the local council shall appoint a committee to review the situation.
3. The appointed committee should review the facts as presented, and, in addition, may interview any persons whose testimony might assist the committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a correct decision.
4. A confidential report will be given to the applicant setting forth the decision of the committee.
5. The applicant may—if he or she does not agree with the decision—request a review from the regional director.
6. If the regional review does not satisfy the applicant, he or she may ask for further review by the National Council. The decision by the National Council is final.

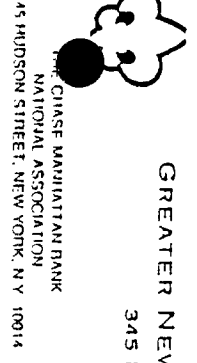

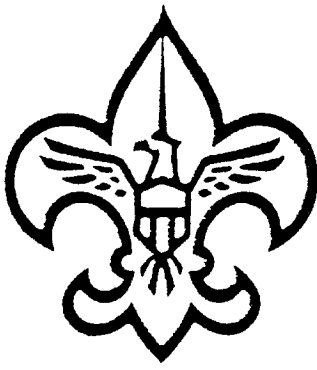


On this date, I received a call from Patrick Coviello, SDE, Staten Island, that Richard Gundacker, SM Troop 37, had called and was concerned that Christopher Diaz, was again working with a Scout troop here on Staten Island. He wanted to talk to me. Upon receipt of Pat Coviello's call, I contacted [REDACTED] at his home and he gave me details concerning Chris Diaz and Troop 52. On a police report (filed in Staten Island Pct 120), it was recorded that an incident had happened at Snug Harbor and the police talked to leaders of Troop 52 camped there at Snug Harbor, to see if they have seen or heard anything. The leaders were Sal D'Agostino, SM Troop 52 and Chris Diaz.

[REDACTED] is really concerned that Chris will not sever his relations with ALL Scouting on Staten Island (his son is one of the boys that reported original incident with Chris Diaz). I assured him we would take necessary action immediately.

Immediately thereafter, I received a call from Michael Mahon, SDE, Staten Island and executive in charge of the district involved, that he was with [REDACTED] a member of the Allowat District Committee and she said that Chris had camped with Troop 52 at Treasuer Island during the weekend of April 2-3rd

Previously Mike had given me a copy of an envelope he had received with a letter from Chris concerning Troop 37's equipment, with Greater New York Councils, BSA and Chris's address - indicating his association with the BSA.

I immediately discussed this problem with our Council President Martin V. Stallone. At this time, we decided that the registration of Chris Diaz should be permanently suspended since her again violated our request to sever ALL relations with the BSA pending decision on his case. It is our opinion, that the BSA cannot tolerate this type of leadership.

CHRISTOPHER DIAZ

On May 31, 1987, Christopher (Chris) Diaz informed Mike Mahon, District Executive, Allowat District, Staten Island, that there were problems within Troop 37, sponsored by St. Teresas Roman Catholic Church, and he was stepping down as Scoutmaster. (Note - Chris is also Vice Chairman, Program, Allowat District and Associate Advisor, OA Lodge.) Also stated he was consulting his lawyer.

Mike then obtained the following information from Father Patrick Quigley [redacted] and [redacted] of Scout [redacted] (age 14) and Scout [redacted] (age 14).

In May 1987, Chris Diaz was requested to step down as Scoutmaster, Troop 37, by Father Patrick Quigley, due to two alleged incidents involving moral life.

The first incident was in June 1986 at a Troop 37 Webelos welcome weekend held at Camp Pouch, Staten Island. Scouts [redacted] and [redacted] said that Chris (sleeping in the middle of both) reached into the sleeping bag and touched their private parts. First one then the other.

The second incident was in October 1986 at Chris' summer home in New York State. Scout [redacted] Scout [redacted] and two other Scouts saw X rated (sexually explicit) films and were given champagne to welcome new SPL. Both boys accused Chris of sexual molestation. Chris slept in a folding lawn chair next to couch and touched Scout [redacted] private parts - two different nights. Also attempted the same with Scout [redacted]

Upon hearing their alleged incidents from the Scouts, and parents, Father Quigley asked Chris to step down as Scoutmaster and all other church youth positions. Chris agreed to do this in lieu of filing complaints with New York Police Department.

On June 18, Chris informed District Executive, Mike Mahon, about the above incident, admitting only to the films and champagne. Was contacting his lawyer.

CHRISTOPHER DIAZ

Ten members of the Troop 37 committee, including Chairman Anthony Defazio, felt the church was wrong in not investigating the matter further. They decided they would start a new Troop with Chris as Scoutmaster. This unit was to be sponsored by the Swedist Home. This action is now being held in abeyance.

I was informed of this matter around July 30th and asked DE Mike Mahon to monitor and stay on top. On August 12th, Mike and I discussed information then known and I asked Mike to ask District Chairman Bob Byrnes to get Chris to resign as District Vice Chairman. The District Chairman, District Executive and myself went on vacation from August 14-24th. While in Florida at Top Hands Conference, I discussed briefly with our Scout Executive, Richard Ruffino, and our Director of Field Service, Lyle Antonides.

Upon return on August 24th, DE Mike Mahon briefed me on this matter. On August 25th I discussed with Council President Martin V. Stallone, after calling Father Quigley and an unoffical call to William L. Murphy, Staten Island District Attorney (an Eagle Scout and member of Staten Island Executive Board) we decided to write Chris a letter and suspend his Boy Scout registration until this matter is concluded. Two complaints had been filed with the New York Police Department and action is pending.

Letter (copy attached) was delivered personally to Chris Diaz by Martin V. Stallone and Bud Hassler on August 26, 1987.

Bud Hassler, SE

August 31st

I attended meeting of Troop 37 parents at St Teresas Church. Meeting was conducted by Tony DeFazio, Troop Chairman and was attended by Father Robert Ashman, Scouting Monitor for the church. I discussed matter with Father Ashman and thanked him for the church doing thier part as sponsor. Twenty-four parents attended this reorganization of the troop. Plans for the new year were discussed and a new Troop Committee Chairman was selected and then approved by Father Ashman. Father Ashman spoke and said we should look forward, not back, and that the church was behind troop 37. He asked if anyone had any questions - there were none.

Bud Hassler, SE

September 1st

I was approached by Bill Murphy, SI District Attorney, at our Rotary meeting, asking me status of our actions. I told him we suspended Chris pending final action by city. I stated that I really had nothing in black and white and he stated that he would send me something soon.

Bud Hassler, SE

November 17, 1987

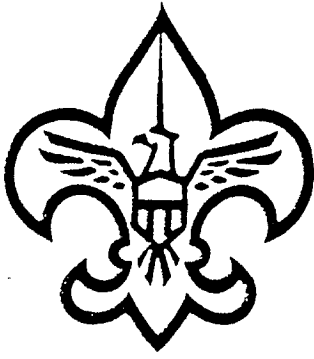


Dear Chris,


