NOTES RELATED TO DONALD ROSEN

August 17th - Call from Tom Kolin, L.A. Council -

Informed of incident at Camp Arrowhead regarding our Troop 672 and Don Rosen, SM. Sexual child abuse implications.

Was told that the incident had been reported to the San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department.

DFS Dick Newton and DE Rick Lake informed.

The incident had occurred during the prior week and the troop has left camp (returned home) prior to the report being filed.

(See Camp Chaplain's statement)

September - Troop suspended operations on their own.

September 21st - Phone conversation with Deputy Kerfoot - L.A. County Sheriff's Dept.

File had bounced around due to law enforcement jurisdiction questions.

He had just received the file. He indicated that the case would now be investigated.

September 22nd - Phone call to Jim Stainer, L.A.Council -

Asked him to send me his notes on the case. These were received (chaplain's notes) in a letter dated 9/24.

September 25th - Phone call to Troop Commissioner Chairman, Charles Zufall.

Troop operations still suspended.

He is to call prior to resumption of troop meetings.

October 23rd -

- A. Rick Lake heard that the troop had resumed operations under the leadership of two Asst. SMs.
- B. Phoned Zufall He still feels that Rosen has been falsely accused and said he received word from "a sheriff's deputy" that no charges would be filed and that Rosen had no history of similar incidents on his record "in the computer."

C. Phoned Deputy Kerfoot -

Case had been transferred to the L.A. County Sheriff's office in La Crescenta.

I asked if Rosen had a prior history of child abuse - answer, "He was convicted in 1980 - was placed on probation. Because of a clean probation, the conviction has been "set aside." That case came about due to his employment with the L.A. School District.

D. Phoned David Park in home office -

Explained the above

He advised that I "follow the green book" and suspend registration.

3:15 p.m. - Called Zufall - informed him that Rosen's registration is being suspended.

3:30 p.m. - Called Rosen's phone number to arrange meeting to deliver "letter of suspension." Got recording. Left office and home phone numbers.

4:20 p.m. - Talked to Ralph Parker to explain action.

September 26th - Talked to Don Rosen -

Explained action "The BSA procedure in these cases is to suspend a person's registration. If you want to apply for registration in the future, you should write to me stating your version of the facts. A council review committee would be formed at that time." I read the attached letter to him.

Dave Berkus, Council Commissioner, has been involved in the process and supports the decision.



On the evening of August 14, 1987, assistent scoutmasters, Joe Toudville. and Wm. Patchen asked me to speak to a boy in their troop who was upset. The from troop 672. When I arrived at the cumpsite, boy's name was was in one of the tents in his campsite upset, and crying. I asked hi. to come outside, and I spoke to him about what had happened. Apperently, his scoutmaster, Don Rosen, had pulled pants, and underwear down. Druing the act, told Don to stop the what he was doing, which was ignored. In the campsite, there were also present, and done acts such as these before. As I found out about this, I also took the chance to talk to the other two boys that were present at the campsite. During the course of the talk with the three boys, it was learned that Mr. Rosen had in one way or another, comitted acts such as these in the past to other members of the troop. Among the acts mentioned by the boys in the confrence, were being grabbed in the rear, as one of the boys was changing cloaths in his slapping bag, Mr. Rosen tried to pull the bag away, two boys were walking to the KCTO and were followed by Mr. Rosen, the boys also told me that Don had had also stuck his hand in the boy's pants before, and told them that whenever he dis uswould say, "This is a love touch." In the course of the talk it was found out. that Don had done these things to almost all the member; of the troop, with the exception of a few of the younger ones, at the end of my talk with the three per , I spoke to the two assistent scoutmasters who said to each other in my presence, "Don has got to learn to keep his hands to himself. This time he did it to be wrond kid, and that will end up getting him blackballed from scouling." I bet them know on the condition of payin, and rest them.
