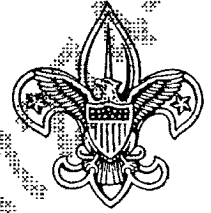
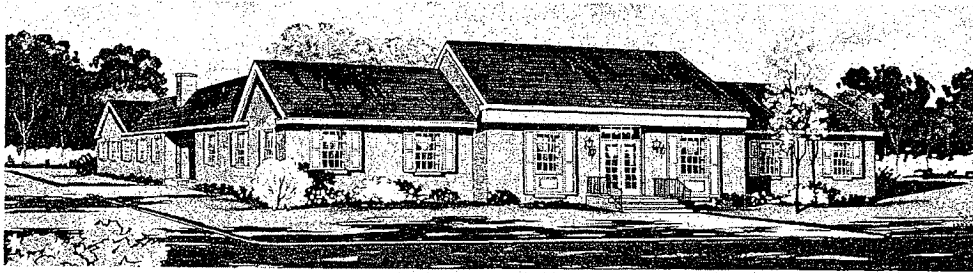

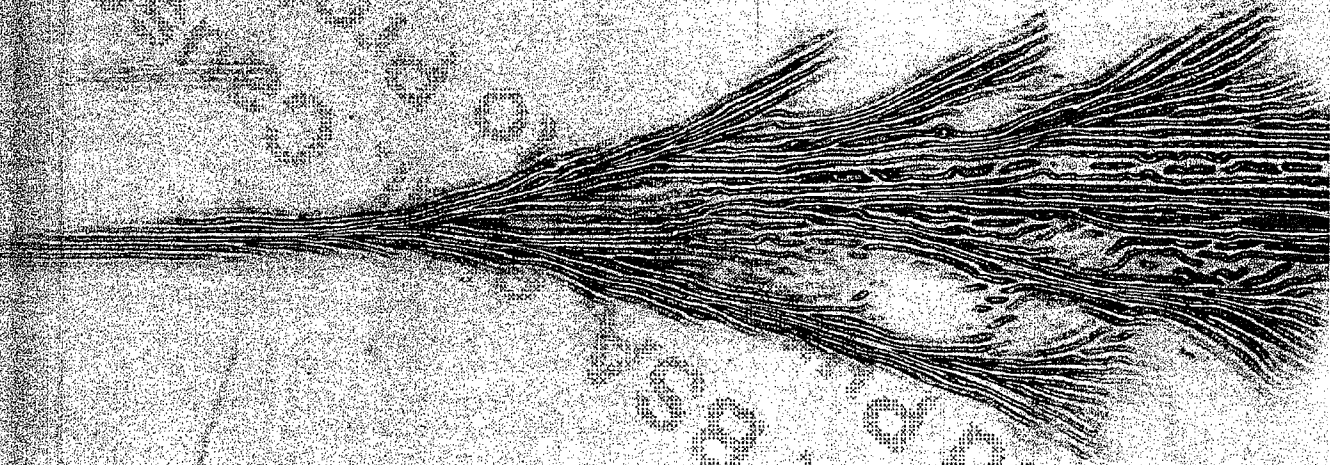

Dear Mr. Maynes,

I have carefully but discreetly investigated the complaints concerning Mr. Donald Wertman formerly associated with the Explore Post of this parish and as per our several conversations have found them to be true.

As you will recall, the complaints concerned certain improper actions between the previously mentioned and several boys in the Post. Without further elaborating on the details, I believe that it will suffice to say that the actions, if brought to the attention of the civil authorities would, in my opinion, lead to probable charges of 'corrupting the morals of a minor'.

It is neither the intention of this parish or me personally to bring this case to the attention of the civil authorities. The sole reason for this intention not to prosecute is a personal conviction that a public involvement of the case, now somewhat past, would serve no value with regard to correcting the damaged minds of the youth involved but would serve only to impress the unfortunate and degrading incidents more firmly in their minds.

I am, however, convinced that the party mentioned can no longer serve the good interest of youth and therefore, upon your suggestion, I am submitting this strictly confidential report in writing.
