

Gentlemen:

I am writing in behalf of Gordon Barrett whom I understand has applied for a position with your organization.

I saw Gordon in individual psychotherapy sessions from August 1969 thru January 1971. During my sessions with him he was cooperative, and well motivated. He followed suggestions and developed considerable insight. I have never felt in the course of my work with him that Mr. Barrett harbored any serious psychological tendencies or perversions. My impression is that what happened to him was largely due to an abnormal situation in which he reacted in a rather normal manner.

There is no reason in my opinion to consider Mr. Barrett psychologically unfit for the position for which he has applied. He has remained highly active in church and community affairs and maintained an excellent adjustment over all.

I sincerely hope that this information will be helpful in your reading a decision concerning Mr. Barrett.

Gentlemen:

Mr. Tagliaboske requested reaffirmation of our findings in regard to Mr. Barrett. These are as follows:

Gordon Barrett had been in active psychotherapy from August 1969 thru January 1, 1971 at the Counseling Service of Clinton County. You are aware of the incident which occurred in the service.

Gordon had been faithful in his appointments and had participated in his therapy commitment. We emphasized the importance of enlarging his social contacts which he did. He also became active in his church.

To our knowledge there have been no recurrence of the incident such as that which occurred in the service. His community adjustment has been good since leaving the service.

Mr. Barrett constantly expressed his desire to re-enter scout work and I told him I would write the above letter for him. I took the liberty of informing him that you would notify him of your decision in his case.

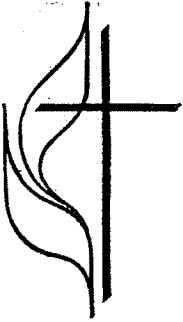



Attached is a letter which was recently received concerning one Gordon Barrett.

Gordon R. Barrett, Jr. was placed on the Confidential File by the Scout Executive of the Kit Carson Council in 1966, where he was stationed in the U. S. Army. He was discharged from the Army at the time he was placed on the Confidential File and returned to his home in Lock Haven, Pennsylvania.

In July of 1969, we received a charter application for Troop 60 of Lock Haven, where Gordon R. Barrett was listed as the Scoutmaster. We refused to register him at that time and another Scoutmaster was found for the Troop.

In my estimation, Dr. Mays' letter says very little. I feel that we need a great deal more information than Dr. Mays has provided. If you would like to pursue the subject further, I suggest that you have a personal talk with Dr. Mays and try to determine if at the present time Gordon Barrett could be trusted to assume a leadership role in Scouting.

I leave the matter in your hands.

During the time that Mr. Barrett was serving in the U. S. Army in New Mexico, he has been registered as Assistant Scoutmaster in Troop 287 at Sandia Base. At the time of his discharge, he made a remark to the Institutional Representative that he planned to register in Troop 61 in Lock Haven, Penn. immediately upon his return home.

Enclosed are Special Orders Number 158, Headquarters, U. S. Army Element Field Command DASA, Sandia Base, New Mexico pertaining to one P. F. C. Gordon R. Barrett, Jr. - RA 13847313.

These orders state the acceptance of a discharge (Class 3 Homosexual).

This individual has been registered as Assistant Scoutmaster of Troop 287 at Sandia Base and I am requesting that he be immediately placed on the confidential file.

I do not know all the details concerning his offenses, but they were several. None to our knowledge concerned Boy Scouts, but were against other Army personnel. The discharge is dated August 10, 1966. The individual departed Sandia Base August 11, 1966 for 355 East Bald Eagle Street, Lock Haven, Penn. He made the remark to the institutional Representative that he planned immediately to re-register in Troop 61 of Lock Haven, Penn. Immediate steps should be taken and this council should be advised to be on the look-out for him and not to re-register him.

Following is a description of this individual: Name, Gordon R. Barrett, Jr.; Age, 21; Height, 5'10" (approx.); Weight 180 lbs. (approx.); Race, Caucasian; Hair, dark blond; Eyes, hazel. Special identifying features: severe case of facial acne.

This individual has been a military cook and plans to seek employment in one of the several hospitals in the Lock Haven area.


