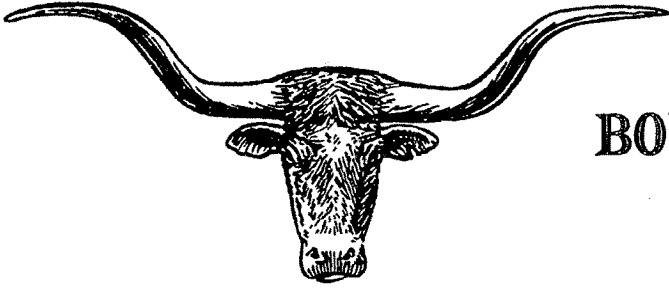

NAME: Howell A. Smith

SCOUTING STATUS: Registered as Assistant Scoutmaster, Troop 185, from June 1964 to June 1965. As far as we can determine, this man is not now registered in any Troop, Pack, Post, or District Committee in the Longhorn Council.

FACTS: Leyman Fleming, District Scout Executive of the Longhorn Council, Boy Scouts of America, received a call from Clarence Youngblood, Deputy Regional Scout Executive, Region Nine, Boy Scouts of America, on the evening of July 26, 1966. Mr. Youngblood had asked for Mr. Henry, Scout Executive, Rex Palmer, Assistant Scout Executive, and third for Mr. Fleming.

Mr. Youngblood made the following report by phone to Mr. Fleming: Mr. Howell A. Smith, age 46, of 2616 Hardy Place, Arlington, Texas, had been arrested by the Vice Squad in a public toilet at the corner of Elm and Akard in Dallas, Texas. The arresting officer had contacted Mr. Youngblood of the Regional Office stating that this man had been arrested on morals charges of suspicion of sodomy and that he stated that he was Scoutmaster of Troop 185, Arlington, Texas. Mr. Youngblood told the police officer that they would inform us of this incident and thanked them for their services.

Mr. Youngblood was contacted by phone by myself Wednesday, July 27, 1966 at which time he reaffirmed the story that he had told Mr. Fleming and added that the accused had propositioned the Vice Squad Officer and that the Dallas Police would handle this man to the extent of the law.

Mr. Ray Smith, District Scout Executive of the Cross Timbers District, is out of the city on vacation and will be on vacation until August 8, 1966.

A telephone call was placed to Dr. Floyd Cash, District Commissioner of the Cross Timbers District, but at the writing of this statement we have been unable to contact Dr. Cash.

Since this man is not now affiliated in Scouting (to the best of our knowledge), no further action will be taken on this case until the Scout Executive, Mr. Kirk Henry, returns from his vacation.
