FACTS:

Leyman Fleming, District Scout Executive of the Longhorn Council, Boy Scouts of America, received a call from Clarence Youngblood, Deputy Regional Scout Executive, Region Nine, Boy Scouts of America, on the evening of July 26, 1966. Mr. Youngblood had asked for Mr. Henry, Scout Executive, Rex Palmer, Assistant Scout Executive, and third for Mr. Fleming.

Mr. Youngblood made the forlowing report by phone to Mr. Fleming: Mr. Howell A.
