Re: Registration Suspension

Dear Mr. Brown:

In response to your request for review of the suspension of your registration, a review committee of three volunteers with Old Hickory Council was appointed to consider your appeal. The charge of this committee was to investigate this matter, consider the evidence presented and then determine whether the suspension of registration was appropriate under the standards set forth in Article VIII of the Rules and Regulations of the Boy Scouts of America, No. 4992. The question before the committee is to decide whether the applicant "possesses the moral, educational, and emotional qualities" necessary to afford positive leadership to youth. A negative determination should not be considered a finding that the applicant is not a decent citizen.

The record before the committee consisted of your hand written letter to several memoranda and statements from various parties, and other information gathered by or on behalf of the committee during its inquiry into this matter. Based upon its review of this action by the council, the committee determined that the decision to suspend your registration should be affirmed, and your appeal is therefore denied.

All information presented to the committee as well as its deliberations and decisions are confidential. You have the right to appeal this decision to a regional review committee within thirty (30) days of the date you receive this notification. Should you desire to pursue an appeal, you should write to the regional president, Mr. James Hackney, P.O. Box 440728, Kenneshaw, Georgia 30144, explaining why you believe the decision of the council review committee is in error.

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A refund of your registration fee is enclosed.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a council review committee, please write to me within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated. The procedures for a review of this decision are attached.

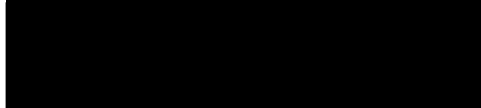
I MUST DISAGREE WITH YOUR DECISION IN YOUR LETTER TO ME DATED JUNE 20, 1988 AND WITH THE TALK WE HAD ON JUNE 27, 1988. AFTER 26 YEARS SERVICE TO THE YOUTH OF OLD HICKORY COUNCIL AND HANLING ROCK DISTRICT THIS DECISION IS VERY DOWN GRADING. I DO NOT KNOW WHAT LIES WERE TOLD TO YOU AS NO ONE WILL TELL ME WHAT ^{WAS} SAID. BUT LET ME ASSURE YOU THAT IT WAS A LIE. I CAN ONLY GUESS THAT THE LIES WERE ABOUT AN INCIDENT THAT TOOK PLACE THE WEEK END OF MAY 27-29. WHILE TALKING WITH TWO SCOUTS IN THEIR TENT ONE OF THE SCOUTS STARTED TO PICK AT ME BY POKING ME IN THE RIBS. I TOLD HIM TO STOP BUT HE DID NOT AND WE STARTED TO WRESTLE DURING THE WRESTLE THIS SCOUT MADE SOME MOVES THAT WERE NOT BECOMING A SCOUT I TOLD HIM TO STOP AND THAT HE SHOULD NOT DO THESE THINGS. AT THAT TIME I LEFT AND WENT BACK TO THE CAMPFIRE. ON JUNE 16 I HAD A MEETING WITH THE TROOP COMMITTEE AND TOLD TWO MEMBERS WHAT TOOK PLACE ONE OF THE PEOPLE PRESENT WAS THE FATHER OF THIS SCOUT HE GRABBED ME BY THE NECK AND SAID HE WAS "GOING TO KILL ME". THEN TO THE OTHER PERSON HE WAS STOPPED. AFTER THAT [REDACTED] SAID "I WILL SEE THAT

YOU NEVER HAVE ANY THING TO DO WITH THIS
TROOP AGAIN." IN NO WAY DID I EVER (OR EVER HAVE
DONE ANY THING OUT OF THE WAY WITH A SCOUT
IN TROOP 444 OR ANY OTHER TROOP IN THE 26
YEARS I HAVE WORKED WITH SCOUTS AND DURING
THIS 26 YEARS OVER 500 BOYS HAVE BEEN IN
THE TROOP. I CAN NOT STAND BY AND SEE THE
LIFE OF ONE BOY CAUSE ME ^{AND THE TROOP} THE WORRY AND
TROUBLE. I FEEL THAT I MUST TAKE WHATEVER
ACTION IS NECESSARY TO CLEAR MY NAME AND
GET MY REGISTRATION REINSTATED AS I WILL NOT
LET A LIE TAKE AWAY WHAT I HAVE WORKED 26
YEARS FOR AS I KNOW I HAVE NOT DONE ANY THING
WRONG. AS GOD IS MY WITNESS, THE ABOVE IS THE
TRUTH AND THE ONLY REASON I CAN GUESS FOR
YOUR LETTER, I REQUEST A REVIEW OF YOUR DECISION.
