SUBJECT:

Sexual Child Abuse

On July 12, 1982, Mike Neeley came to me and said that some Scouters were coming in regarding possible sexual child abuse. Mike asked me to sit in on the meeting.

, Scoutmaster Troop 405, Mike Neeley, and myself met in Bob Gagner's office at the Scout Service Center.

The following incidents were reported as possible child abuse by Jim Froehlig, Scoutmaster of Troop 179.

- 1. Troop 405 and 179 attended Many Point Camp together (1981). Froehlig stopped by camp. Was holding and cuddling a child believed to be a Webelo Did not know who he was. Was taking this child and a Scout of Troop 178 to camp at Itaska State Park.
- 2. On various occasions, Froehlig observed touching boys that adults didn't think quite right. Grabbed on leg. told him to keep his hands off his son.
- mentioned an incident concerning his son, Froehlig grabbed penis and told him "Don't pull back and it won't hurt". This occured at Many Point over Memorial Day, 1982.
- 4. Both troops went together on a trip to Buffalo, Wyoming from July 1, 1982 to July 10, 1982. an ol<u>der boy</u> in Troop 405 was friendly with of Troop 405. told not want to sleep in Froehlig tent because he was afraid of him because of way Froehlig had touched him. After returning home, told his father, who contacted and and touched him. talked to who confirmed his conversation with his father.
- 5. While on the above trip, Froehlig was observed with Froehlig's lap and Froehlig cuddling him.
 - 6. Froehlig insisted that his crew of boys sleep in the nude or if using pajamas, then they should not wear undershorts.
 - of Troop 179 stated that "touching" of boys had happened with other boys in the troop.

From the above discussion, it was decided that the following be invited to a meeting in the Council Service Center for Thursday, July 15 at 7:30 P.M.

SUBJECT:

Followup Meeting on Troop 405 & Troop 179

On Thursday, July 15, the following met in the office of the Scout Executive at 7:30 PM: Greg Brown, James Vratisensky, Charles Hilgedick, Jack McDevitt, and Keith Kelsey.

After going over the information contained in my previous report, it was decided to try and get ahold of Froehlig and ask him to come to the Council office. We reached him at 10:15 P.M. and he appeared at 10:45 PM. I was asked to be the spokesman for the group.

I stated that some allegations had been made against him in regards to fondling of boys. I then went through the instances mentioned in my first report after which Froehlig remarked "I have to say that the allegations are true".

I told Froehlig under the the circumstances he should not be in contact with any members of his troop again. He agreed.

It was agreed that Froehlig would be given the opportunity to call the Hennepin County Child Protection Agency and report the incidents and seek help for himself. He was to call me the following day after he had called. Jim Froehlig called today and in a 3-way conversation with Jack McDevitt and myself he reported that he had contacted the Child Abuse Agency, this was later confirmed, and that he had an appointment with a doctor this coming Monday. He said he was going to contact his priest because he needed some help right away. Jack and I urged him to do this.

I have advised Andy Wangstad of this situation.

Jack and I urged the Troops to have a program on Child Abuse conducted for their Troops as soon as possible. Jack also agreed to send some materials that could be helpful for such a meeting.
