INDICTMENT - aggravated sexual battery

This 26th day of March, 1985, came the Commonwealth, by her Attorney, and the Defendant, JEFFREY A. SAWYER, who stands indicted for a felony, to-wit: aggravated sexual battery, appeared agreeably in accordance with his recognizance of bail; also appeared JEFFREY A. SAWYER, Counsel for the Defendant.

Thereupon, the Court Reporter was sworn.

Whereupon, the Attorney for the Commonwealth moved the Court to amend the indictment by striking the words "sexually abuse" and "touching her intimate parts or clothing covering such intimate parts" and by adding the words "with lascivious intent to expose his sexual parts to" and "and propose to said child that she touch such sexual parts" changing the charge to "Indecent liberties". which motion the Court granted without objection by the Defendant or his Counsel.

Whereupon, the Defendant was arraigned upon the amended indictment returned herein, to which the Defendant in person and in writing signed by him, entered a plea of guilty. and the Court after specific inquiries of the Defendant, being of the opinion the Defendant fully understood the nature and effect of his plea of guilty and that the same was voluntarily and understandingly made, accepted the said plea of guilty and the written plea is filed herein and made a part of the record of this case.

Thereupon, the Court heard the stipulated evidence as proffered by the Attorney for the Commonwealth and in consideration of the Defendant's plea of guilty and the evidence heard, the Court doth now find JEFFREY A. SAWYER, guilty of Indecent Liberties, as charged.

Thereupon, Counsel for the Defendant moved the Court to refer this case to the District Probation Officer for his investigation and report before sentencing, which motion the Court granted.

This case is hereby continued to the 17th day of May, 1985, for said report and sentencing.

The Defendant is hereby continued on bond.

PLEA OF GUILTY TO A FELONY

and my age is _____

1. My name is Jeffrey [unclear] years.
2. I am represented by Counsel whose name is C. Wilton and I am satisfied with his services as an attorney.
3. I have received a copy of the warrant or indictment before being called upon to plead, and have read and discussed it with my attorney, and believe that I understand the charges against me in this case. I am the person named in the indictment. I have told my attorney all the facts and circumstances, as known to me, concerning the case against me. My attorney has discussed with me the nature and elements of the offense and has advised me as to any possible defenses I might have in this case. I have had ample time to discuss the case and all possible defenses with my attorney.
4. My attorney has advised me that the punishment which the law provides is as follows: A maximum of 5 years imprisonment (and a minimum of 1 years imprisonment) or, in the discretion of the Jury or the Judge sitting without a jury, up to 12 months in jail and a fine of not more than \$ 1,000, or both, also that probation may or may not be granted; and that if I plead guilty to more than one offense, the Court may order the sentences to be served consecutively, that is, one after another.
5. I understand that I may, if I so choose, plead "Not Guilty" to any charge against me, and that if I do plead "Not Guilty" the constitution guarantees me (a) the right to a speedy and public trial by jury; (b) the process of the Court to compel the production of any evidence and attendance of witnesses in my behalf; (c) the right to have the assistance of a lawyer at all stages of the proceedings; and (d) the right against self-incrimination; (e) the right to confront and cross-examine all witnesses against me.
6. I understand that by pleading guilty that I waive my right to an appeal; and that I am admitting that I committed the offense as charged and that the only issue to be decided by the Court is punishment.
7. The following plea agreement is submitted:

No Agreement

8. I understand the Court may accept or reject the agreement, and may defer its decision as to the acceptance or rejection until there has been an opportunity to consider the pre-sentence report and other evidence.
9. I declare no officer or employee of the State or County or Commonwealth's Attorney's Office, or anyone else, has made any promises to me that I would receive a lighter sentence or probation if I would plead guilty. In addition, no one has threatened me and thereby caused or influenced me to plead guilty.
10. After having discussed the matter with my attorney, I do freely and voluntarily plead guilty to the offense Indecent Liberties 18.2-370, Criminal No. 44732, and waive my right to a trial by jury and request the Court to hear all matters of law and fact.

On October 31st, Albert Kugler - Scout Executive of the Stanford Area Council, Palo Alto, California - called Roger Ohmstede - Scout Executive to inform him that a Scouter who was a relative of Mr. Sawyer had reported to him that Mr. Sawyer had a conviction for *child abuse* in Fairfax, Virginia.

The report was referred to me, and I talked with Al Kugler on November 1st to get further details. I also gave Al Kugler additional background information we had on Mr. Sawyer from his Camp Staff application in regard to his high school graduation, date of birth, etc. to confirm that we were discussing the same person. Al Kugler called back on November 5th to report that the Jeffrey Sawyer we were discussing was the same person. He reported to me that Jeffrey had a Dishonorable Discharge from the United States Navy for some type of child abuse.

I called you to discuss this case; and we agreed it would be best to suspend Sawyer, pending completion of our investigation.

I, through an employee in our office, found how to secure records regarding Sawyer from the Navy and have done so. Copies attached.

Today, November 8th, we delivered a letter of suspension to Mr. Sawyer.

Attached is Sawyer's *Application for Membership, Camp Staff Application*, and his *Suspension Letter*.
