ISSUE: Child Abuse and Embezzlement of Pack Funds.

FACTS: The facts as related to me by Fritz Bachman, Cindy Andress, Den Leader, and Amy Gregory, an unregistered adult observing the pack are as follows.

On or about November 30, 1987, Amy Gregory audited the Pack's bank account to check the payment of dues by the Cub Scouts. She reported that the Cubs were \$40 behind in dues.

She reported that all Cubs were current in dues and that the dues had been turned over to Carol. Hensen weekly for deposit. There have been no deposits made to the account since May or June, 1987 despite the dues (40) and proceeds of two garage sales (\$200) being entrusted to Carol Henson for deposit. Further, at least two checks appear to have been made for withdrawals from the account bearing the forged signature of signature.

Further, Jerry Henson has threatened and has, in the past, "crashed" den meetings to haze the boys.

Beyond that, Carol Henson, as the treasurer also of the Girl Scout Troop has embezzled funds from that bank account.

Further, Jerry Henson has abused girl scouts by pushing or slamming one against a wall, by fondling another, and by holding a little girl on his lap inappropriately.

On yesterdays' date all of the above scouters and professionals from Girl Scouts attended the den meeting to wait for Jerry Henson to appear. Upon his arrival, the police were summond for Henson had said he was coming with a gun. The police and I intercepted Henson outside and I informed Henson of all of the above assertions. Henson agreed to terminate his relations with Scouting and to regrain from speaking to or calling anyone involved in Scouting including Cub Scouts and Girl Scouts.

He denied all assertions, however, agreed to leave Scouting and not attempt to return. I expect him and Carol Henson to work the same way with Scouting Units in Arizona for they travel there every month, reportedly, to establish residency.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of membership the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be granted or reinstated. The procedures for review are attached.
