

Re: John Atwood youth molestation incident

Summary of incident:

On Friday, August 2, 1991, Mr. John Atwood and youth [REDACTED] spent a night in a hotel room in San Diego County, en route to Lost Valley Scout Reservation. During the night, Mr. John Atwood provided alcohol and got [REDACTED] intoxicated. [REDACTED] fell asleep and was molested during the night. [REDACTED] alleges that he was awakened from his sleep by John Atwood fondling him. [REDACTED] continued to feigned sleep while John Atwood proceeded to orally copulate him.

The next day while at Lost Valley, [REDACTED] confided in [REDACTED] one of the weekend volunteers of the camp. Subsequently, [REDACTED] confided to one of his friends, [REDACTED]. According to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] also stated that he had been victimized by John Atwood.

[REDACTED] shared this information with [REDACTED] camp ranger, and with me on August 16 while at Lost Valley. I proceeded with the youth protection guidelines and contacted Ted Cox. I presented my suggested outline for action which you agreed to. The details follow.

Note: This action did not take place on a Scouting event nor on Scouting property. However, the parties involved are members of the Orange County Council.

MEMORANDUM**Chronology:**

August 2, 1991:

On Friday, August 2, 1991, Mr. John Atwood and youth [REDACTED] spent a night in a hotel room in San Diego County, en route to Lost Valley Scout Reservation. During the night, Mr. John Atwood provided alcohol and got [REDACTED] intoxicated. [REDACTED] fell asleep and was molested during the night. [REDACTED] alleges that he was awakened from his sleep by John Atwood fondling him. [REDACTED] continued to feigned sleep while John Atwood proceeded to orally copulate him.

August 3, 1991

While at Lost Valley, [REDACTED] confided in [REDACTED] one of the weekend volunteers of the camp. [REDACTED] in talked with [REDACTED] helped him find a place to work during the day to avoid further contact with John Atwood, and provided transportation for [REDACTED] to his home on Sunday, August 4, 1991.

Approximately August 10, 1991

[REDACTED] confides in his friend [REDACTED]

Approximately August 14, 1991

[REDACTED] tells his parents of the molestation. Mr. [REDACTED] contacts San Diego County Sheriff office, Deputy Collier, and reports the incident. [REDACTED] Deputy Collier advises the [REDACTED] not to discuss the incident further.

August 15, 1991

10:30 am: [REDACTED] arrives at Lost Valley. He recently talked to [REDACTED] who requested Andrew Harake to call Deputy Collier and report what he knows. [REDACTED] tells [REDACTED] and Ron Schoenmehl of the incident.

August 16, 1991

3:20 am: [REDACTED] attempts to call Deputy Collier. [REDACTED] is advised to call later that afternoon.

9:40 am: Ron Schoenmehl calls Ted Cox and informs him of the incident. (Note: Scout Executive Kent Gibbs is out of the state and will not return until next week. Mr. Cox, director of field service, is on vacation and Schoenmehl calls him at home). Mr. Cox agrees to the plan and the further steps recommended by Ron Schoenmehl.

8:50 am: Ron Schoenmehl reports the incident to Mr. Dave Graska, Scout Executive of Ventura County Council. (W: 805/482-8938; FAX: 805/484-9172) This report is made because Mr. John Atwood resides in that council and is a former Scoutmaster of their Troop 210. Ron Schoenmehl feels that John Atwood could be currently registered in that troop or participate in a non-registered capacity. (Subsequently, Graska informs Ron Schoenmehl that John Atwood is not registered in that council). **Schoenmehl requests that Ted Cox follow up with Graska.**

9:20 am: Ron Schoenmehl reports the incident to Child Protective Services of San Diego County, Anna Baker, ([REDACTED]).

9:42 am: Ron Schoenmehl talks with [REDACTED] and requests they send a written statement from either the victim or the parents to Ron Schoenmehl at the service center, marked confidential. This report would be part of the confidential file for national.

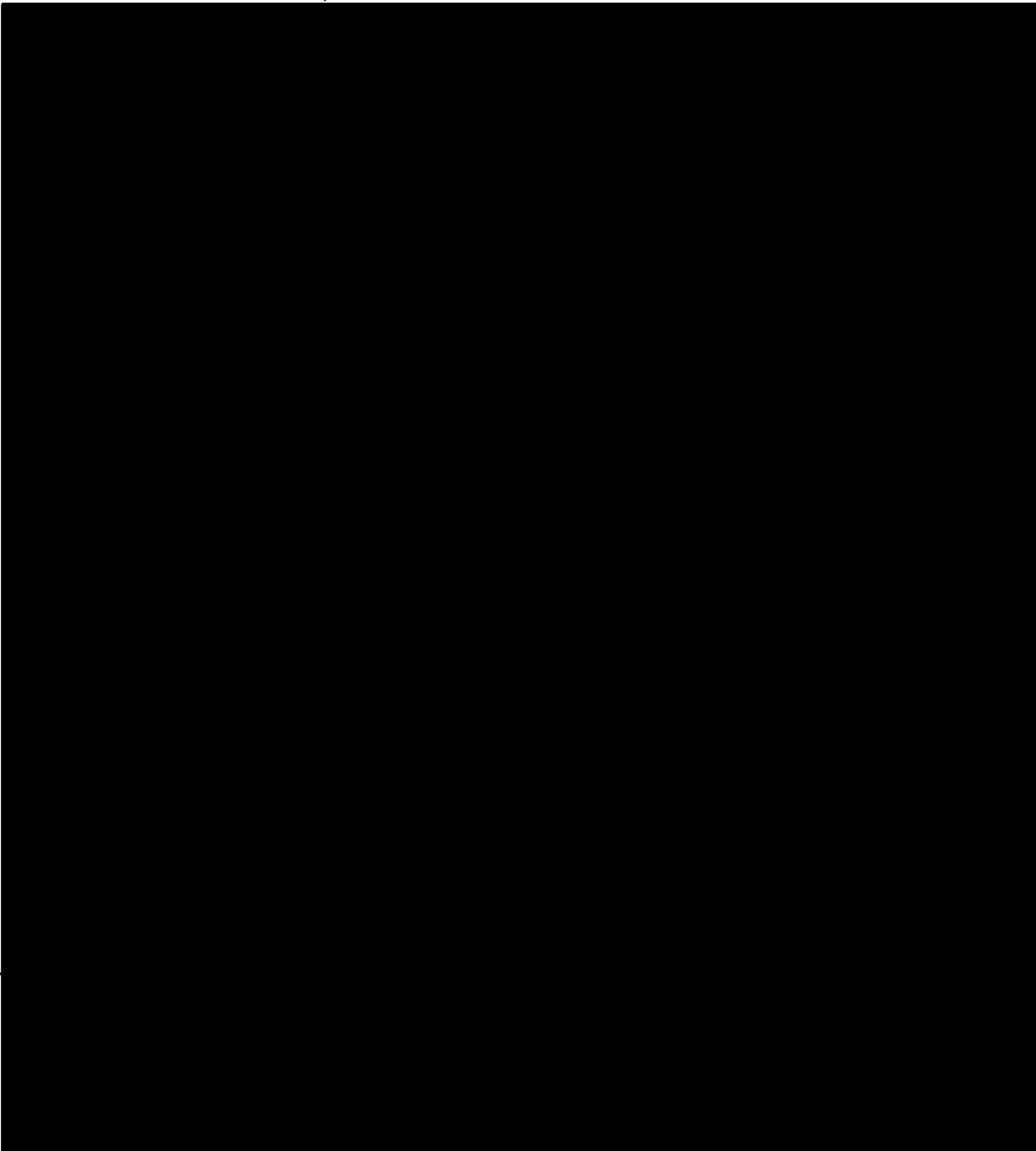
9:50 am: Ron Schoenmehl talks with [REDACTED] and makes a similar request as above. [REDACTED] indicates that he is reluctant to make such a statement. (In a previous youth protection incident not related in any way to this and not involving [REDACTED], a report was made by another son of [REDACTED] regarding a youth who claimed to be homosexual. The council suspended the membership of this alleged homosexual and the accused appealed the suspension. After a review by the regional committee, the membership of the accused was reinstated. [REDACTED] feels this action was not in the best interest of Scouting and feels his other son was put in a difficult position, the incident mishandled). [REDACTED] states he prefers allowing the legal authorities to handle the incident.

August 17, 1991

12:05 am: Shortly after midnight, John Atwood arrives at Lost Valley. Ron Schoenmehl asks John Atwood to join him in the business office. He also asks Rodney Sonderman to accompany them.

Ron Schoenmehl presents John Atwood with the letter denying him membership in the Boy Scouts of America. Atwood asks what the nature of the charges are and

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to refuse registration whenever there is concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a BSA regional review committee, please write to the regional director within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be granted. The procedures for a review of this decision are attached.

The following information is provided should you desire a review by the Western Region, BSA, of the decision to deny your registration.

1. Within 60 days, you must request in writing a review of this decision. Your request should be sent to: Western Region, 185 North Wolfe Road, P.O. Box 3464, Sunnyvale, CA 94088-3464. In your request you must include your version of what occurred in support of your claim that registration should not have been denied.
2. Upon the receipt of your written request, a committee will be appointed to review the situation.
3. If the regional review committee determines that a review hearing is necessary, the committee will advise you whether or not you may attend. In some instances, no useful purpose would be served by having the applicant present. The hearing is not adversarial in nature and neither the committee nor you, if you attend, will be represented by legal counsel. If you wish, in the event you attend, you may be accompanied by no more than two other individuals if their testimony might assist the committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a correct decision.
4. The committee will review the facts as presented, and may interview any persons whose testimony might assist them in arriving at a correct decision.
5. You will receive a letter setting forth the decision of the committee.
6. If you are dissatisfied with the decision of a regional review, you may request a further review by the National Council. The decision of the National Council will be final.


