Police: Scoutmaster molested boy again

A former assistant scoutmaster serving two years probation for indecently assaulting a 12-year-old boy has here arrested for another attack on the same of the conficials said yesterday.

I Joseph Smedley Jr., 25, of the 100 blow of Bonsall Avenue in Aston was arraigned on Monday in Monroe County Court on charges of molesting the boy during a Pocono camping trip in July 1986, said Pennsylvania State Trooper Thomas Mastruzzo of the Swirtwater barracks.

Smedley pleaded not guilty to a charge of involuntary deviate sexual intercourse and was released on his own recognizance after posting \$1,000 bail, officials said.

Mastruzzo and Trooper Malcom Murphy of the Media barracks said the additional charges against Smedley surfaced during the original investigation into complaints that he molested the same boy during an overnight camping trip in Concord Township in May 1986.

Smedley pleaded no contest to that charge in August 1987, but only after creating a controversy in the Media Courthouse.

Delaware County Judge Domenic D. Jerome wanted to sentence Smedley to the Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition program, which would have given him the opportunity to clear his criminal record.

But Smedley objected to Jerome's order that he stay away from teen-age boys, and the judge listed the case for trial. Smedley agreed to stay away from organized activities with children after pleading no contest.

Smedley, a volunteer assistant scoutmaster since 1981, was suspended shortly after the original charges surfaced.

Sex suspect still scouting, officials say

ASTON — An assistant scoutmaster suspended from Boy Scout activities after he was charged with molesting a 12year-old boy has attended recent meetings, confirmed a scouting executive, the victim's parents and police sources.

John Joseph Smedley Jr., of the 100 block of Bonsall Avenue, "apparently did come around a couple of times and come to troop (223) meetings" at a church, according to Albert Smith, executive of the Valley Forge Council of Montgomery and Delaware Counties.

Smedley faces trial in county court on charges of indecent assault, corruption of minors and endangering the welfare of minors. The charges stem from an overnight trip to Camp Toland at Concord and Station roads in May, authorities said.

Smedley allegedly entered the tent where the victim, an Aston boy, was sleeping and indecently touched him, state police said.

A week after the arrest, a Boy

Scouts spokesman said Smedley was suspended from all activities pending outcome of the case.

"I talked to scoutmaster Bill Mack," Smith said. "He said he (Smedley) had been around a couple times and I reiterated Smedley is not to be active with the unit until the matter is resolved," Smith said Thursday.

Asked if Mack agreed with his recommendation, Smith replied, "Yes, absolutely."

"We're not making any accusations or anything. It's in the courts now," he said.

"Our primary concern, of course, is protecting young people," Smith said.

He pointed out that Smedley, a volunteer assistant scoutmaster since 1981, isn't a paid member of the scouting staff.

Volunteers are selected by a sponsoring troop committee, such as a church sponsor coordinator, Smith said.

"The scoutmaster and someone else met with Smedley to reaffirm the recommendation for the good of scouting in the area," Smith said.

Smedley's attorney, Clarence D. Bell Jr. of Media, declined to return messages left Thursday and Tuesday.

Mack couldn't be reached forcomment Thursday and a woman who identified herself as Smedley's wife said her husband would have no comment.

The Daily Times learned from the parents of the victim that they saw Smedley's truck parked outside the church during troop meetings the past three Monday nights at the Mount Hope United Methodist Church on Concord Road.

The tather, whose name is being withheld by the Daily Times to protect the identity of the juvenile victim, said he saw Smedley coming out of the church Monday night with Mack.

"Smedley was wearing a Boy Scout hat," the father said.

He said he called state police who in turn contacted township police, headquartered across the road from the church. A police officer confirmed the truck's license tag number as Smedley's.

"I'm almost positive he was in the Aston parade, Tricentennial, with other Boy Scout fathers," the father said.

That incident prompted the parents to check the meetings to see if he was attending them, the father said.

A police source close to the investigation said he was contacted by the parents on a Monday night in November and told that Smedley's pickup truck was parked outside the church. Another officer verified the registration, he said.

Scout leader faces sex rap

CONCORD TOWNSHIP — An assistant scoutmaster, was arrested last week on charges of molesting a 12-year-old Aston boy at during an overnight camping trip, state police said.

John Joseph Smedley, Jr., of the 100 block of Bonsail Ave., Aston, was arraigned before District Justice Leon Mascaro on charges of indecent assault, corruption of minors and endangering the welfare of children, state police said.

He was released on \$3,000 bail pending a hearing 10 a.m. Oct. 14.

May Smedley allegedly entered the tent
where the victim was sleeping and indecently touched him, state police said.

In subsequent trips with the Boy Scouts to Dauphin, Berks and Monroe Counties, "similar acts were committed upon the victim," according to state police.

Charges are pending in Monroe County, according to Trooper Malcolm Murphy.

Smedley, who was associated with Troop 223 in Aston, has been a volunteer assistant scoutmaster since 1981, according to a spokesman for the Boy Scouts of America Valley Forge Council of Montgomery and Delaware counties.

"He's been suspended from all activities pending outcome of the case," he said.
