- Mr. Cotton recommended we contact local police about additional information.

Tuesday, December 8, 1987

- Contacted local police no public disclosure files available.
- Referred by the Springfield police to circuit clerk's office.
- Circuit clerk had no public disclosure files and we were referred to the Sangamon County State's Attorney office.
- Spoke with Cheryl Essenberg, attorney in State's Attorney office. No record existed of a John Sanford. Records were only for Sangamon County of Illinois.

PM I phoned David Park, attorney for the National Council, f America, and reviewed with him the entire file regarding. The recommendation received from Mr. Park was that it would sk that John Sanford resign from his leadership position Scouts of America, and particularly Cub Scout Pack 354.
