Please find attached the documentation of the incident involving John Nykamp as stated by Stan Klevan, then Scoutmaster of Troop 168, Stockton. Mr. Klevan is a police reporter for the Stockton newspaper and as such has provided a rather thorough accounting of the incident. Also find attached the required form for removal from membership.

Since this incident occured in 1986 before the current proceedures were established we thought it would be appropriate to forward this information to you. We also were able to secure recently the disposition of this case from the Nevada County, California, District Attorney's office.

When I first received word of the incident I instructed the camp director to notify the authorities - which he did. In addition, John Nykamp was suspended immediately. After consulting with the Associate Regional Director, Richard Parker, we then proceeded to talk to the parents and inform them that John had been immediately suspended and that the BSA would not tolerate this type of conduct. We have just recently acquired the information regarding the disposition of the case: John Nykamp was sentenced to 2 years of Supervised Probation by Nevada County. Case #M87550 and probation #A870158. The parents of the victims in this matter seemed relieved and satisfied with our actions. We have not heard from them since my original contact.

Paul, I hope this is all you will need to process this - please let me know if I can be of any further assistance.




Staffers at Tamarancho are generally expected to be at least 14 years old. Marin Sierra Staffers are generally expected to be at least 16 years old.
