Thanks for your help in protecting the youth of America.

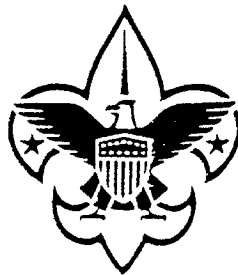

I just received the official indictment from the Supreme Court of the State of New York against John Rosenquist for Sodomy in the Third Degree.

On July 27, 1990, Mr. Rosenquest was tried and found guilty of the lesser included offense of an attempt to commit the crime of sodomy in the third degree.

On September 13, 1990, Mr. Rosenquist was sentenced to the term of probation three years and to enroll in any program recommended by the probation department.

Enclosed is a copy of the official miscellaneous certificate No. 6061 signed by the county clerk and clerk of the Supreme Court, New York County.



On Tuesday, March 13, 1990 the New York Police Department notified our office that [REDACTED], father of Scout [REDACTED] of Troop 687, Manhattan, had filed a formal complaint of sexual abuse against Charter Representative, John Rosenquist of Pack and Troop 687.

In response to the allegations the formal Appendix B letter was hand delivered by myself, as Scout Executive and witnessed by Field Director, William L. McLaughlin on March 13, 1990, at 3:40 p.m. to Mr. Rosenquist at his place of employment along with a refund check for his registration, suspending him from all activities with the Boy Scouts of America.

On the evening of March 13, 1990, I met with the Scout, [REDACTED] and his father [REDACTED], to confirm the incident and offer the Boy Scouts' extreme apology for the incident occurring. We met at the Scout's home. District Executive, Angel Concepcion was present during the meeting. I also offered the option that counseling is available through the National office for both [REDACTED] and his family and agreed to be in contact with the family on a regular basis.

On the morning of March 14, 1990, I met with the Pastor, Father Francisco Irurtia of the Holy Agony Church, [REDACTED], New York City to discuss the matter and convince the Troop Committee to move the Scouting program forward.

Mr. Rosenquist was expected to be arrested on March 14, 1990 and charged with sexual misconduct to a minor. A full investigation by the Police Department is being conducted.
