Ex-Scout leader receives 13-year prison sentence

Maintaining he felt he did nothing wrong at the time, a former Boy Scout master, school teacher and coach and participant in Big Brothers/Big Sisters was sentenced to 13 years in prison for indecency with a child from a jury that deliberated almost five hours on the punishment

The seven-woman, five-man jury took only 25 minutes to determine the guilt of Joseph Gallagher, 37, convicted for indecency with an 11-year-old child he had met at a boy scout ranch last July.

The defendant, dressed in a green suit, white shirt and green-striped tie, testified Wednesday he had obtained a sample of his sperm in the presence of the boy at the child's request. He referred to the incident

as "purely academic."

In other testimony, the child said there was sexual contact between the two at Gallagher's request. The defendant denied those allegations.

During the trial, Gallagher said he feit at the time he was doing noth-

ing wrong:
"Obviously there was an impact
on his mind," he said in response to
a question from his attorney Vernon Reichle, "but it was knowledge. He was ignorant before his request...!t did affect him. I'm sure. But it was

After the trial, he said he realized the child must have feit differently because the boy walked away when Gallaguer approached him in the hallway outside 142nd State District Judge Pat Baskin's courtroom.

Under cross examination by Assistant District Attorney Chuck Roades, who asked Gallagher if he thought he did anything wrong, Gallagher rentied: "Obviously he the boy thinks I did."

"But you don't?" Roades asked.

"It doesn't matter what I think. It matters what he thinks." Gallagher replied. "At that time, I did not think I was doing anything immoral."

The former boy scout master at St. Ann's School testified that he felt he had to share the knowledge with the

boy.
"If I denied his request, he'd just go down and get it somewhere else," he said. "Possibly at school, possibly at church and possibly down behind some bushes somewhere. It was purley academic.

"Are you aware of the consequences of such action?" Reichie asked. "Of the media publicity given to sexual child abuse and molesta"I realize there are people abusing children. I sure do." the defendant responded.

'Would you abuse a child?" Reichle asked.

"Never."

"Because they are valuable and the good Lord made them." Gal-lagher said. "He made their bodies, made they souls. He made every-

Gailagher, who has a bachelor of arts degree in English and physical education and endorsements (or teaching driver's education and the emotionally disturbed, was a substitute physical education teacher at Trinity School. Several students from the school were present during the trial to offer the defendant moral support, they said.

The former boy scout leader also taught emotionally disturbed classes at Lee Freshman High School dur-ing the 1981-82 school year. Accord-ing to a spokesman for Midland Independent School District, Gailagher resigned during the spring semester of 1982, but finished the school term. A spokesman for Trin-ity School said the defendant is no

longer used as a substitute teacher.

No former employers testified on his behalf but Midland County Com-missioner Win Brown and consuiting geologist Jeremiah McCarthy testified as friends of Gallagher's

whom they said was an affectionate and trustworthy person.
"He's open and friendly, more so than most people" said Brown, who also testified he had known Gallagher for eight years. Gallagher coached his children at St. Ann s. Brown said.

Others monitoring the trial included members of the Midland Rape Crisis Center and Big Brothers/ Big Sisters program, in which he participated.

"He did work in the program at one time, but he was dismissed," said director Linda Galvan. "It was not for sexual indecency or any thing like that. He had disobeyed some ground rules.

She added Gallagher was in the program for youths with single parents about four years ago.

Under the second-degree felony conviction, Gallagher faced a sentence ranging from two to 20 years in prison and a fine of up to \$10,000. Because he had no prior (elony convictions, he was eligible for a probated sentence, which he told the jury would benefit him and society.

But Roades and Administrative Assistant District Attorney Tom Morgan disagreed.

Your whole life has been devoted to teaching children, is that correct?" Roades asked Gailagher.

"If this jury let's you walk out of here a free man, do you plan to continue doing that?"
"I do," Gallagher said.

Gallagher, whom Morgan called the "Pied Piper of sexual perver-sion" during closing arguments, will appeal the conviction, according to his attorney.

Because he received a sentence of

15 years or less. Gallagher is eligible to be released on an appeal bond. Although prosecutors asked Baskin to double the bond from the original \$7,500 bail "because of what happened Tuesday and Wednesday, Baskin said he would set the bond at

\$10,000 today.
Gallagher, who spent Thursday night in the county jail, was late to court on Tuesday, causing post-ponement of the trial, according to sources. Wednesday, he arrived before the appointed 8:30 a.m. time, but left after apparently thinking the trial was not going to begin. His attorney found him at his house and he was back in court before the trial began at 9 a.m.

I strongly request the Boy Scouts of America immediately terminate any association with Mr. Joe Gallagher due to his sexual abuse of my eleven-year old son.

My son and I met Mr. Gallagher this summer at a Boy Scout function. As a result of this meeting, Mr. Gallagher developed a friendship with my son and subsequently was given the opportunity to spend time alone with him. On two occasions Mr. Gallagher exposed himself to my son and induced my son to manually stimulate him to the point of ejaculation.

After learning of this, I filed a complaint with the District Attorney's office. Mr. Gallagher has been indicted by the Grand Jury for indecency with a child. He is now free on bond and is awaiting trial.

I make this report to the Boy Scouts of America in hopes that no other boy will be exposed to humiliating and psychologically damaging sexual abuse from this registered adult and former leader of the Boy Scouts of America.
