

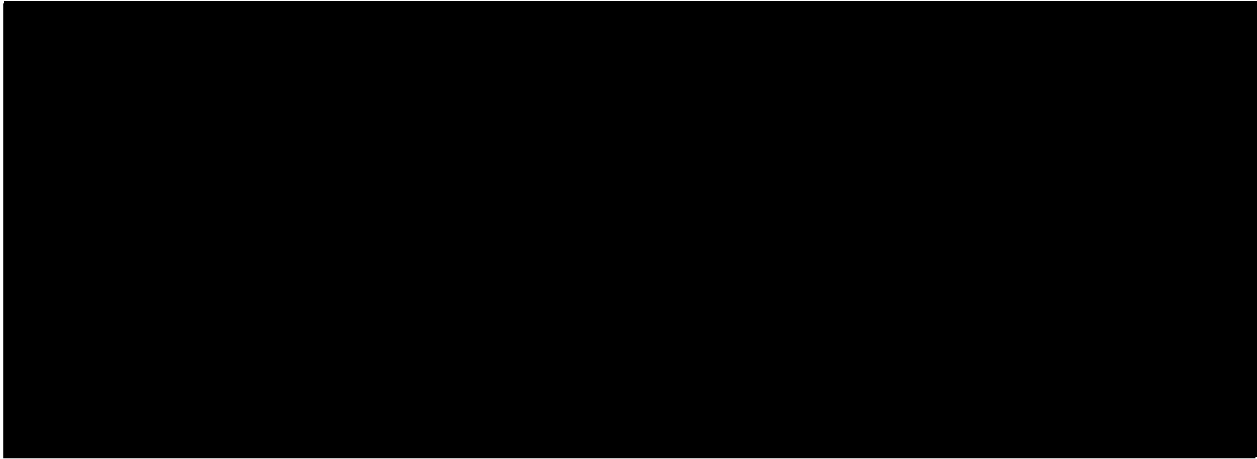



WHEREUPON it is adjudged by the Court that the Defendant Larry James David be remanded to the common jail of said County and there safely kept until a guard shall be sent from the Penitentiary of this State, by the State Board of Corrections and then delivered to said State Board of Corrections and said Defendant Larry James David be imprisoned in said Penitentiary, or elsewhere in the State, as the State Board of Corrections may direct, for and during the full term of 14 year minimum and 14 years maximum to be computed from this date. Molestation: Former Scout leader, three others indicted

A former Maysville Boy Scout leader and three other men were indicted Monday by a Jackson County grand jury on charges related to child sex crimes.

The former scout leader, James Scott Rodgers, was indicted on one count each of child molestation and sodomy. The charges were levied in November following an investigation by the Jackson County Sheriff's Department and the Georgia Bureau of Investigation. Rodgers, 46, is accused of molesting two members of his scout troop while on a field trip in Houston County last year.

Rodgers was taken into custody in Houston County, where he had been charged with one count of aggravated child molestation. The Jackson County charges stem from an investigation spawned by the alleged incident in Houston, which also reportedly involved a Maysville troop member.

Rodgers allegedly fled out the

back door of his home when Jackson County authorities arrived to serve warrants in late November. The suspect was quickly apprehended, however, when bloodhounds were brought in to assist in the search. The investigation is said to have stemmed from a complaint issued in late October to the Georgia Bureau of Investigation office in Athens by a Jackson County parent.

THREE OTHERS INDICTED

The grand jury also indicted the following men on charges of child sex crimes:

--John Phillip Brookshire, two counts of child molestation.

--Larry James David, five counts of child molestation and one count of influencing a witness.

--Dennis Eugene White, child molestation and aggravated child molestation.

The four men will be arraigned at 9 a.m. Monday in Jackson Superior Court.

Ex-Scoutmaster denies charge; 1 gets 10 years on sex case

Former Maysville Boy Scout Leader James Scott Rodgers has pled "not guilty" to all charges stemming from allegations that he molested members of his troop on a field trip last year.

Rodgers, one of four men indicted by a Jackson County grand jury last week on child sex-related charges, is slated to stand trial in Jackson Superior Court at a later date. He is charged with one count each of child molestation, aggravated sodomy and sodomy. Rodgers entered his pleas of "not guilty" at Monday's arraignment hearings in Superior Court.

ONE GETS 10 YEARS

Among the other three men indicted last week on child sex related charges, only one, John Phillip Brookshire, pled at the arraignments.

Judge Penn McWhorter levied a 10-year prison sentence against Brookshire, who pled to two counts of child molestation. In addition to his prison term, he also was fined \$2,000 and ordered to pay victim counseling costs.

Slated to stand trial in separate cases are Dennis Eugene White, who pled "not guilty" to child molestation, aggravated child

molestation, sodomy and aggravated sodomy, and Larry James David, who pled "not guilty" to five counts of child molestation.

Local law officers charge 15 with DUI

The Jackson County Sheriff's Department and Commerce police charged 15 people with driving under the influence of intoxicants (DUI) during the past week.

Jefferson police made no DUI arrests during the past week.

- Terry Waters, 28, Commerce, also no insurance, operating faulty equipment, driving on the wrong side of the road and possession of marijuana.
- Jose Bravo, 20, Athens, also possession of alcohol under age 21, driving on the wrong side of the road and obstruction of a police officer.

Rodgers convicted

Former Scout leader gets 40 years on molestation

A former Maysville Boy Scout leader has been sentenced to 40 years in prison after being found guilty of molesting boys in his troop.

James Scott Rodgers, 46, was found guilty Tuesday afternoon in Jackson Superior Court of child molestation and sodomy. The jury deliberated about an hour, with the verdict coming at 12:10 p.m.

The case has not been appealed, although defense attorney Jerry Gray made numerous motions for a mistrial throughout the proceedings. Most of Gray's motions were based on whether some of the state-presented evidence was relevant to the charges. However, Piedmont Circuit Superior Court Judge James Brooks repeatedly cited reasons for denying the motions and, at times, appeared angered with Gray's persistence.

The trial got underway with opening arguments around 11 a.m. Monday. Following a lunch break, the courtroom was closed to the public for most of the afternoon as at least three juveniles from Rodgers' scout troop testified. Allegations against Rodgers reportedly stemmed from incidents that occurred on a camping trip with his troop in Houston County.

In addition to the juveniles, whose testimonies were kept confidential, the prosecution, led by Piedmont Circuit District Attorney Tim Madison, called to the stand

two inmates with whom the defendant allegedly made sexual overtures to while being held in confinement. They were Jimmy Ballenger, 21, and Christopher Edward Galbreath, 20, who was housed with Rodgers for a brief period while serving a sentence on burglary.

Galbreath's testimony provided little for the state's case. The inmate repeatedly responded to Madison's questions with, "I can't recall, sir. It was just so long ago."

However, another state witness, Georgia Bureau of Investigation agent Janet Hunnicutt, testified that Galbreath's recollection was "excellent" on the day she took a report from him in regard to what happened between him and Rodgers in the jail cell. According to the report, Rodgers had asked his cellmate whether he wanted a massage and Galbreath became angry.

"Didn't you tell Mr. Rodgers to get the hell away from you?" was one of the questions Madison asked Galbreath. Again, Galbreath said he couldn't recall.

Madison's questioning often focused on the allegation that Rodgers once worked in an gay massage parlor in Atlanta and that he often bragged that he "knew the most modern techniques" of massage.

Hunnicutt also testified how

Rodgers fled out the back window of his mobile home the day agents arrived to serve his arrest warrant. A canine unit from Alto was brought in to help apprehend Rodgers, who was hiding in a wooded area behind his home.

Among witnesses for the defense was 28-year-old Ronald Godfrey, who had lived with Rodgers as his roommate for the past four years. Godfrey was a partner in Rodgers' business--a Maysville produce farm. Much of Gray's questioning was aimed at showing the jury that Godfrey was present most of the time Rodgers was on the farm with boys in the scout troop. Godfrey said he never witnessed anything unusual between Rodgers and the boys. The troop met at Rodgers' home since it had no other meeting place, he said. Godfrey, who did not go on the

camping trip, said Rodgers had told him of an incident involving a troop member in Houston County. He said one of the boys had apparently had a bad dream while on the trip. Rodgers took the boy outside the tent at the campsite to talk to him and the boy told him he had dreamed another boy in the troop was having sex with him, said Godfrey.

Testimony from character witnesses revealed that Rodgers had been asked repeatedly by community members to assist with the scout troop and that he was reluctant at first to do so.

Testimony from one of the defense witnesses, who is the mother of a troop member, apparently backfired. Gray's questions to the mother focused on Rodgers' character. However, when the state cross-examined the

witness, Madison almost immediately asked whether her son had told her about what happened on the camping trip. The woman began to cry. She indicated her son had apparently been molested by Rodgers and that the boy had become "very withdrawn" after the trip.

"He sat on the couch, all up in a knot," she told Madison. "He wouldn't let anyone touch him."

Rodgers was serving in a voluntary capacity as head of the troop and his application for becoming an official scout leader was being processed by Boy Scouts of America at the time of the criminal charges.

Most of the boys in the troop were ages 10-12 and, as was revealed during testimony, some worked at Rodgers' farm for pay.

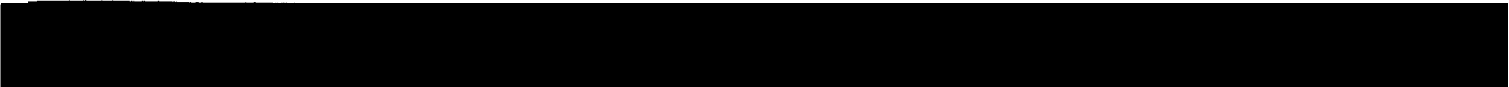

Scout Workers Arrested On Molestation Charges

Two Maysville area men who worked with separate Boy Scout troops were indicted for child molestation charges this week by a Jackson County grand jury.

The grand jury indicted James Scott Rogers, 46, on two counts of child molestation, while another Maysville scout troop worker, Larry James David, 40, of Route 3, Jefferson, was indicted for five counts of child molestation.

Two different scout troops were involved in the cases, which were investigated by the Jackson County Sheriff's Department and the Georgia Bureau of Investigation.

Sheriff Stan Evans said David, who was arrested Jan. 9, has been released on bond, while Rogers, who was arrested last November, remains in jail. Rogers is also charged with aggravated child molestation in Houston County, which stems from a scout outing the troop was on in that county.

The David investigation was an outgrowth of the Rogers case, which apparently spurred some alleged victims to come forward, authorities said. David was also involved in a sports booster club in Jackson County and helped coach young boys ages 9 through 11, according to a GBI report.
