Scout assistant gets term in '76 rape of city boy, 11

An assistant scoutmaster who pleaded guilty last year to raping an II-year-old member of his Boy Scout troup was sentenced today to one year in the Hennepin County Workhouse work-release program.

Hennepin District Judge David R. Leslie also ordered Martin Ronald Koski. 31, to participate in a rehabilitation program for sexual offenders after four months of courtordered psychological evaluation.

Leslie, who could have sentenced Koski to up to 20 years in Stillwater Prison on the criminal sexual conduct charge, said he was impressed by Koski's cooperative attitude and his willingness to change his behavior. The work-release sentence means Koski can keep a job during the day, but must stay at the county facility at night.

Koski pleaded guilty last Dec. 28 to the rape of a Minneapolis boy who was helping him move furniture into Koski's apartment at 3104 Dupont Av. N. Koski had been an assistant scoutmaster for seven months at the time of the rape.

Scout leader charged with sex abuse of boy

An assistant Boy Scoutmaster has been charged with allegedly sexually molesting an 11-year-old Scout.

Martin R. Koski, 31, 3104 Dupont Av. N., will be arraigned today on charges of first-degree criminal sexual conduct and sodomy. The charges stem from a Nov. II incident involving Koski and a Minneapolis boy.
