Sodomy Trial

Two Men Convicted in Acts
With Six Teenage Boys

NEW YORK (UPI) — A former Boy Scout leader who plied low-income youths with drugs and alcohol to get them to perform sex acts has been convicted of 25 counts of sodomy for abusing six teenage boys, including a deaf mute.

It took the jury of six women and six men in state Supreme Court in Manhattan just five hours to reach a guilty verdict against Michael Olaskowitz, 40, an office manager for the Board of Education.

Also convicted in the case was Hilton Eldredge, 50, a driver for a cheese cake company, who was found guilty of 58 counts of sodomy as well as conspiracy.

A TRIAL BEGINS

Sodomy Charged to Two Men

An October 7 trial was set for two Upper West Side residents; one of them a Boy Scout leader, who was arrested early last year on charges of conspiracy and sodomy in connection with the sexual exploitation of boys between the ages of 13 and 16.

The two men, Michael Olaskowitz, 38, of 135 West 73d St., and Hilton Eldridge, 50, of 155 West 76th St., were arrested on March 22, 1986.

Along with two other men, Ralph Fernandez and Luis Paredes, both of the Bronx, who pleaded guilty earlier this year and were each sentenced to prison terms of one and a half to four and a half years.

Joint Investigation

The arrests came after a five-month investigation by a city police and FBI joint task force on the sexual exploitation of children. An undercover agent of the task force had infiltrated the ring, according to District Attorney Robert M. Morgenthau.

Olaskowitz, who worked as clerk for a teacher-training program administered by the United Federation of Teachers at the time of his arrest, was described as a long-time Boy Scout and Cub Scout leader in an active member of an active West Side church.
