
Dear Basil:

Sorry to be late with these forms, but had a hard time trying to get information about these men. No one wants to talk about them very much.

Because of their ages, I think it is safest to place them in the confidential file, and prevent them from serving in Scouting any more. They are pretty confirmed homosexuals according to the testimony of the two younger men, and would be dangerous to boys. Meckel is said to have taken part in the "orgies" which started the rumors in the Post and Troop which led to the investigation.

I wish I could get you more information, and shall certainly send more along when it can be obtained. The principal in the case is still out on bond, having thrown himself on the mercy of the court. When his psychiatric examination is completed, he will be sentenced by the judge.
