Meckel is said to have taken part in the "orgies" which started the rumors in the Post and Troop which led to the investigation.

I wish I could get you more information, and shall certainly send more along when it can be obtained. The principal in the case is still out on bond, having thrown himself on the more of the court. When his psychiatric examination is completed, he will be sentenced by the judge.
