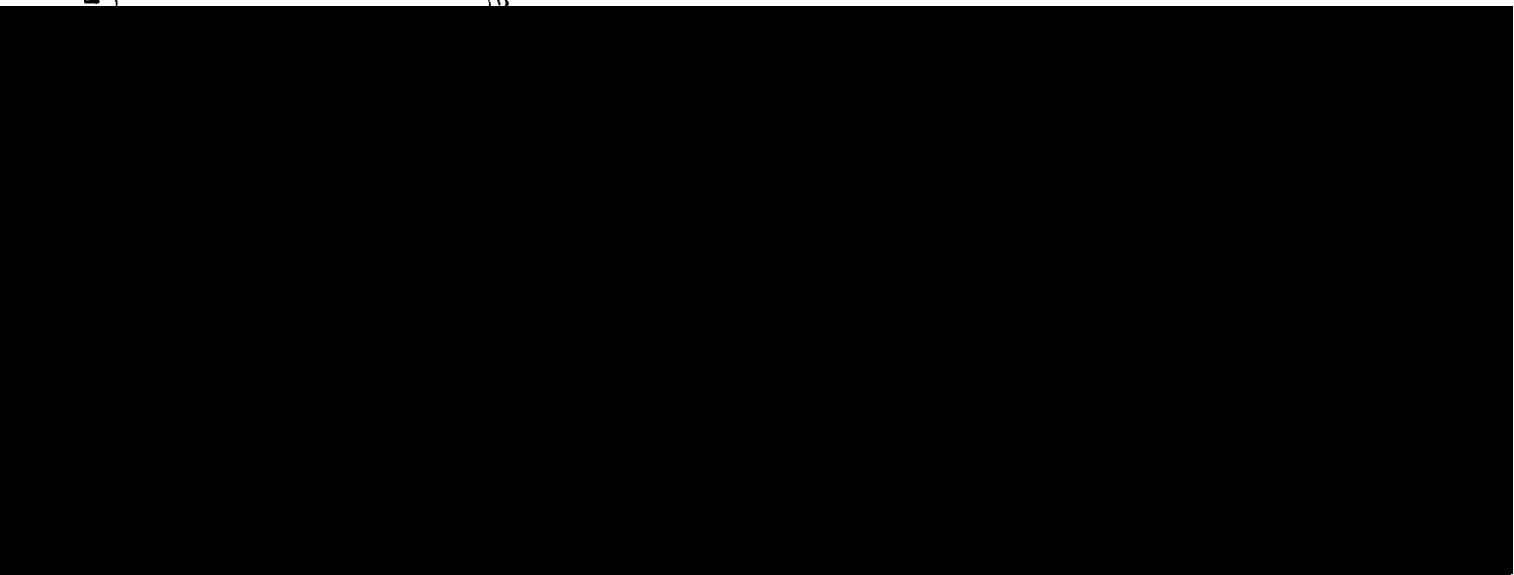

Dear Ron,

As we had discussed several weeks ago, Troop 1152 is very concerned by the behavior of one of our older scouts. At your request I have attempted to describe here, as sufficiently as possible, the nature of this objectionable behavior.

The following is a recount of the interviews conducted by Mr. Bert Hall and myself with two scouts who have been affected by our problem. On August 7th we had a discussion with [REDACTED] and his father. [REDACTED] originally brought the problem to our attention.

[REDACTED] was asked to explain the nature of his problem with Rex Spencer. [REDACTED] told us that on a hike to San Bernadino Peak in March of 1984 he shared a tent with Rex Spencer. Rex began a sexual conversation with [REDACTED] that began with "Have you ever had sex with a guy?" Rex then explained how he masturbated and asked [REDACTED] if he wanted to see his (Rex's) penis. [REDACTED] said no and then Rex asked if [REDACTED] would show his penis to Rex. [REDACTED] refused. Rex then asked if he could touch [REDACTED] penis and [REDACTED] again refused.

The conversation ended then with Rex explaining to [REDACTED] what happens when a guy has sex with a girl. [REDACTED] stated that Rex never attempted any physical contact. I asked [REDACTED] if he knew of any other boys who might be having a problem with Rex. He said that we should also talk to [REDACTED].

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Bert Hall and I then went to [REDACTED] home on the evening of August 28th to discuss this problem with him. [REDACTED] explained that he had a conversation with Rex Spencer at a camporee during May of 1983. On that occasion Rex talked to [REDACTED] about "having sex with a male." [REDACTED] said that he did not respond and Rex dropped the subject. [REDACTED] stated that he has had no further problem or discussion with Rex since that time.

Ron, the parents of the troop are very concerned about this problem. Rex was seventeen when these conversations took place and it seems that we cannot pass this off as adolescent play. Rex is now eighteen years old and as he is now an adult, we feel the problem is potentially more serious.

Conversations such as have been described by [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are clearly not part of the spirit of scouting which we are working so hard to instill in the boys. It is our hope that with your guidance this problem will be solved quickly and with as little risk to the boys as possible.
