August 20, 1970

The following statement was made by on August 19, 1970 to members of the Troop Committee of Troop 216. (Persons present - Ernest Vculek, Fred Brown, Paul Olson, Reverend Reverend Reverend Gary Galchut and Robert McGrew).

On a camping trip to St. Croix State Park on August 2, 3 and 4, the Scoutmaster invited me to go with him into the woods. After we had gone about a mile we were at the river and he asked me if I would like to go swimming now in the nude. The Scoutmaster removed my shorts and asked me to remove his. When we were naked he asked me to lay on my back and he began tickling me. He said that one thing we needed to learn was mouth to mouth resuscitation. He showed me how and then asked me to practice on him. (still in the nude) . . . never did go swimming:

On the way back to the campsite he asked me if he could spank me. He then removed my trousers and undershorts and held me over his knees while he played with my buttocks, spanked me and squeezed my penis. (Called the actions an "initiation".)

stated that on the way to the State Park that the Scoutmester said one thing they (the Scouts) needed to learn was how to keep a secret as they would possibly do some things that should be kept secret from their parents.

Reverend stated that this was essentially the same statement made to him by on return from the camping trip. After further investigation and conversation with other boys it was determined that at least one other boy had been subjected to a similar initiation.
