APPLICANT PROCEDURE FOR REQUESTING REVIEW OF DECISION DENYING REGISTRATION

- I. If registration is refused, the applicant may request a review of this decision. This request must be in the form of a written request from the individual which includes his or her version of the facts supporting the claim that registration should not have been denied.
- 2. Upon receipt of the written request for review, the president of the local council shall appoint a committee to review the situation.
- 3. The appointed committee should review the facts as presented, and, in addition, may interview any persons whose testimony might assist the committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a correct decision.
- 4. A confidential report will be given to the applicant setting forth the decision of the committee.
- 5. The applicant may if he or she does not agree with the decision request a review from the regional director by submitting a written request for such a review within 30 days of the receipt of the local council decision.
- 6. If the regional review does not satisfy the applicant, he or she may ask for further review by the National Council by submitting a written request for such a review within 30 days of the receipt of the regional decision. The decision by the National Council is final.

Thanks for your letter of May 25, concerning the above named individual. This is most helpful as we start a file which will lead to refusal of registration if the charges are documented to be true.

We would suggest you try to get a statement from about what happened at the time of the molestation. This should be as descriptive as possible, so we have information that will substantiate the refusal of registration.

You might also ask the church to do a check of the individuals now in the troop to see if anyone has been molested who is presently active in the troop. Statements from this individual or the parents would be most helpful.

We will want an Ineligible Volunteer Record Sheet, so we can identify Mr. Haytock. I have enclosed one for your use.

If any charges are filed, naturally we would want newspaper clippings or court records substantiating that and also the outcome of the legal action.
