The attached newspaper article should explain most of the problem.

Rev. Robert Hopkins resided on Main Street, Lee Center, NY and was Pastor of the United Methodist Church at Lee Center and Point Rock.

He is moving out of the area, but where, is still not known.

Pastor admits reduced charge

The Rev. Robert J. Hopkins, St. Lee Center, who is pastor of the Lee Center and Point Rock United Methodist Church, admitted a harrassment charge Sunday that was reduced from a third degree sexual abuse charge involving a 10-year-old Lee Center boy.

State Police at Troop D. Oneida, reported that Mr Hopkins was taken into custody Sunday by Investigator Robert C Hinds on a warrant

State Police said the incident occurred Oct 27

Town of Lee Peace Justice Howard Meyers gave Mr Hopkins a conditional discharge, directing that he week pyschiatric help. Sincerely,
