This letter is in reference to an incident involving Robert K. Brown an Assistant Scoutmaster of Troop 61 in Smyrna, Georgia.

On December 7 th 1988 Scoutmaster John Jenkins called an emergency Troop Committee meeting to inform us of a matter of grave importance. He told us that on December 5 th 1988 told him on a Troop campout at Hard Lapor Creek this past August. Scoutmaster Jenkins immediately took out side the socut looks to discuss the situation in private.

Prior to learning of the incident. Pobert Brown has not attended the regular Monday night scout meetings for several weeks. In. Senkins belied his house to find out what was wrong and learned that Pobert was living in East Point. Mr. Denkins called Robert and he said

and reported the incident to the Cobb County Police Department. After the meeting Mr. Jenkins called and told Mr. Jenkins was true, and that Robert had been arrested and changed with child molestation. Was very upset that the had told Mr. Jenkins about the incident.

During the emergency Troop Committee meeting Scoutmaster Jenkins called the Cobb County Police and asked for any information that was of oublic record concerning the incident, and was told that Pobert K. Brown was arrested on November 11 th 1983 and charged with child molestation in Cotb County. On November 21 so he was released on \$25,000 bond approved by Fuiton County.

After learning this Booutmaster Jerkins recommended to the committee that Robert K. Brown be dismissed as Assistant Scoutmaster of Troop of and asked the committee to act on this immediately. He also asked the committee to write a letter to the Atlanta Area Council of our actions.

The Troop Committee voted unanimously to remove Robert K. Brown as Assistant Scoutmaster and submit a letter to the Atlanta Area Council.

This letter is to inform the Atlanta Area Council of our actions on the Troop level and respectfully request that Atlanta Area Council take what ever action it deems recessary, to prevent Robert K. Brown from taking part in any acousting activities in the future, should the Area Courcil deem it necessary.

We regret having to take this action without proof of guilt in Robert Showns case, but feel that as responsible adult leaders, it is our duty to take all necessary precautions in this matter, to do all we can to insure a moral atmosphere in all of our scouting activities.

Scoutmaster Jenkins has enacted a rule for troop of scouting activities in the future there will always be two or more adult leaders present during any and all scouting activities, with no exceptions.

The actions taken by the Scoutmaster and Troco Committee are in no way intended to reflect any judgement as to the guilt of Robert K. Brown, and is not intended as an act of defamation of his character.

We request your prompt consideration in this matter and will be more than Facoy to assist the Atlanta Area Council in any way we can. If possible please inform troop 61 of the Atlanta Area Councils actions. Thank you for your attantion to this important matter.
