# guilty of ex assault

Vernon Daniels, whose daughter and stepson testified that he used them for sex and home movies, was found guilty of aggravated criminal sexual assault by a Circuit Court jury Thursday night.

The jury deliberated less than three hours before returning the verdict to Circuit Judge John Sype, who set a sentencing hearing for Dec. 5.

Sype allowed Daniels to remain free on bond until sentencing. However, he ordered Daniels to cooperate with the Winnebago County Probation Department in preparing a presentencing report.

Assistant State's Attorney Ron White said Daniels faces between six and 30 years in prison. A 1980 conviction of taking indecent liberties with a child could be a factor in the sentence, White said.

Daniels' wife, Estelle, 31, was convicted of a similar charge in a bench trial before Sype in March. She is serving a six-year prison term.

Daniels showed little reaction throughor the two-day trial.

stifying Thursday, he denied the accus. He said he believed his stepson n up the story in anger after learning that Daniels was not his real father.

The boy, 13, and his sister, 11, told the jury they had engaged in sexual activities with both their parents from the ages of 8 and 6. They said their parents called the activity "family touching."

The boy testified that Daniels made five or six home movies of the sessions.

Winnebago County sheriff's deputies said they did not find any films during their investigation. The boy testified that he thought the films had been sold in Mexi-

The Illinois Department of Children and Family Services took the children from the Daniels home in August 1985 after neighbors told authorities the boy had described the sexual activities to neighborhood children.

Daniels and his wife were arrested in October.

in closing arguments Thursday, White told the jury; "It's going to be a long time and take a lot of therapy to make them (the children) normal because of what he did. He took their innocence and love and used it: tisfy his own perverted desires."

iels attorney, Richard Berry, urged the ry to weigh inconsistencies in the boys testimony as well as what he called a "sexual sophistication" beyond the boy's years.

He said there was ample reason to suspect the boy "fabricated" and "fantasized" for investigators and that he "dragged his boor, young, tender sister into a web of lies to over up his own perserving."

## Rural couple charged

A rural Rockford man and his wife have been arrested by Winnebago County sheriff's detectives on charges of aggravated criminal sexual assault upon a child, Detective Sgt. Billy Burgess said Saturday.

Being held under \$50,000 bond each are Vernon Daniels, 40, and his wife, Estelle, 30, 4339 Brookdale Drive. Burgess said a second charge of unlawful use of weapons and possession of firearms was filed against Vernon Daniels, under circumstances unrelated to the sex offense.

Because the case involves a child, Burgess would say only that the victim is under the age of 13 and that the investigation had begun about 11 weeks ago. He said the Illinois Department of Children and Family Services worked with Detective James Thompkins in the investigation.

Daniels was arrested in 1980 on a charge of taking indecent liberties with a child and was placed on five years probation after pleading guilty in January 1981.

Aggravated criminal sexual assault is a Class X felony, with a possible penalty of six years to life in prison.

Burgess said the weapons charge against Daniels involved a .38-caliber pistol.
