I found that William Tomczak is helping with Troop 6 which is sponsored by St. Joseph's Roman Catholic Church so I talked to Father Ruhling. Father Ruhling, Frank Bednar, the District Executive and I met with Tomczak last Saturday evening.

He told us that he had received a Bad Conduct Discharge. He also told us that six months from his discharge he could apply for a hearing to get his discharge revoked. He has applied for this but a date has not been set for the hearing.

He said that he wants this cleared up soon as he wants to finish college and seminary to become a priest and cannot until he is cleared of this. We told him that he could not reregister with the Boy Scouts of America.

If anything else turns up on this or if I hear about his hearing, I will let you know.


